(d)(1) Each dealer licensed under this subchapter shall maintain a licensed location.

(2)(A) When a dealer changes or moves his or her license location, the dealer is required to notify the Department of Arkansas State Police in writing of the dealership name, the previous location and the new location.

(B) The notification shall be made within fifteen (15) calendar days of the relocation of the business.

(3) If it is determined that the business location has moved and notification to the department has not been properly made, a penalty equal to the amount of the license fee shall be levied by the department.

(4) The penalty shall be deposited in the State Treasury and credited to the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund to be used for the purchase and maintenance of state police vehicles.”
