**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES**

**MISSION**

The State Board of Architects is responsible for regulating the practice of architecture in Arkansas and for the enforcement of the provisions in the Arkansas Architectural Act. The board provides examinations, issues certificates of registration and licenses. The board is composed of eight members.

**TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET**

The total budget for the State Board of Architects is \$347,497 the first year and \$354,048 the second year of the biennium.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The State Board of Architects is a cash funded agency funded from the receipts of fees including registration and renewal fees, fines and penalties.

**II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGES**

**OPERATIONS** - Deletion of Capital Outlay and an increase of 12,250 each fiscal year in Operating Expenses.

**IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE**

**PERSONAL SERVICES** - The Architect Clerk/Bookkeeper shall also be responsible for the administrative activities for the Arkansas State Board of Landscape Architects. The Arkansas State Board of Landscape Architects shall pay to the State Board of Architects an amount equal to one-half (1/2) of the salary of the Clerk/Bookkeeper and the appropriate matching. To be paid during the first quarter of each fiscal year.
