**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES**

**MISSION**

The Board responsibilities include registering, regulating interior designers, and to prohibit the use of the title of "registered interior designer" by persons who are not registered. A registered interior designer is a design professional who is qualified by education, experience, and examination as authorized by an authority. The Board consists of seven members.

**TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET**

The total budget for the State Board of Registered Interior Designers is \$10,635 each year of the biennium.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The State Board of Registered Interior Designers is a cash agency funded from fees collected for registration, registration renewals, and examinations.

**II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS**

The Board of Registered Interior Designers operates from one appropriation.

**CASH OPERATIONS -**

The operating appropriation for \$10,635 each year of the biennium provides for a reclassification of \$2200 from Professional Fees to Operating Expenses to pay for advertising in the At Home in Arkansas magazine.
