**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES**

**MISSION**

The State Board of Disease Intervention Specialists was created by Act 107 of 1993 as a seven member board to license and regulate specialists who educate, investigate and counsel individuals infected or exposed to sexually transmitted diseases, including HIV.

**TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET**

The total budget for the State Board of Disease Intervention Specialists is \$2,360 for each fiscal year of the biennium.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The budget is funded with cash funds generated from fees charged by the agency.

**II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS**

The Operations appropriation funded by cash funds provides base level funding of \$2,360 each fiscal year of the biennium. Executive recommendation provides for the elimination of the Board as a separate agency and transfer of the Boards functions, duties and funding to the Department of Health and Human Services - Division of Health.
