Remarks by Speaker of the House Robbie Wills

Ladies and gentlemen of the House, my remarks today will be short and sweet...which I hope will set the tone for this session, a session that will also be concise, focused and brief!

Last year, as we opened the regular session, I challenged you. I asked you to let statesmanship, dignity, and decorum govern our actions. I said "Don't be a Do-Nothing, be a Do-Something." I challenged you to not only do something but also accomplish something for the people of Arkansas.

And you rose to the challenge and did just that.

But, as pleased as we may be with the last year's Regular Session, I've always believed that accomplishments are something to build on, not rest on.

This year we have that opportunity.

Coach Lou Holtz always says, "If you're still talking about what you did yesterday, you haven't done anything today." That's just his way of saying accomplishments are something to build on.

And that's the challenge I make to you today: Let's build on our accomplishments by doing three simple things: Get in, get the job done, and get home!

The people of Arkansas have sent us here with their votes. Individually, by electing us as their representatives, and collectively, in this session, by approving Amendment 86 in the last election.

Through this amendment, our constitution now requires us to meet in fiscal session. I stress, FISCAL session. And to meet for a limited number of days. That is exactly what we will do.

The people of Arkansas always seem to have a sixth sense about what's best for them individually, and for our state. Because, you see, this first-ever fiscal session couldn't have come at a better time.

The economies of our state and nation are being severely impacted by the most challenging set of circumstances since the Great Depression:

A housing crisis leading to a banking crisis, which led ultimately to a crisis of confidence.

And as we gather here today, 100 thousand Arkansans are looking for work, as we have the highest unemployment our state has seen in over 20 years.

In this limited session, we have the opportunity to do something to meet these challenges. And that opportunity is to be good stewards of our financial resources, prioritize state spending, and pass a balanced budget.

You see, our state budget - although much larger - is just like a household budget for any family in Arkansas. When times are good, you save as much as you can. When times are tough, you have to tighten your belt, set priorities and make tough choices. And at the end of the day, the budget has to be balanced and you have to live within your means.

Well, times are tough and we have tough choices ahead of us.

But the news isn't all bad.

We'll take advantage in this Fiscal Session to allow Arkansas families with college-age children to plan for the future by setting the amounts of our new lottery scholarships.

Very soon, you'll have the chance to vote to fund \$5,000 scholarships for qualified students at four-year schools, and \$2,500 scholarships for those at two-year schools.

We'll provide these scholarships not only for the incoming Freshmen this fall, but also for the Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors. And we'll dedicate a significant amount of scholarship money to part-time and non-traditional students.

This is great news for the state of Arkansas!

We'll also vote on the Revenue Stabilization Act, which will set our spending priorities. Those priorities include continuing economic development efforts to create jobs; Pre-K through 12 and higher education funding to prepare our children for the jobs of tomorrow; and workforce education and training to meet job opportunities of a changing economy.

All of this is important work.

And for the first time in our state's history, the entire state will be watching while we do it.

Beginning with this session, we are throwing the doors of the House Chamber wide open through our on-going Public Access Initiative.

First, we've moved the physical barriers in our public galleries that separated our constituents from their Legislature. The glass walls in the East and West Galleries are gone, and the North Gallery is now fully accessible to those with disabilities.

For those joining us here, you've never been closer to the action.

But most significantly, the doors are wide open for those who can't be here in person.

Members, right now, at this moment, you are on live television! Video and audio of this session, and every session from now on, will be viewed as live streaming video on the new House website - ArkansasHouse.org - where it will also be archived for on-demand viewing in the future.

The Arkansas Education Television Network is using this new technology, making the broadcast available to Arkansas cable television providers all over the state, many of whom have joined us live today on AETN-2.

Also, AT&T U-Verse is carrying our proceedings live, and they've made us part of their line-up of channel offerings.

And C-Span has also asked us to provide video of today's Joint Session, which we are also doing through AETN.

By the regular session of 2011, every meeting of every committee and every session of the House will be available for viewing.

It is time for more access, not less. More transparency, not less. And more communication with the people of Arkansas so they can see first-hand, without barriers, how their tax dollars are being spent.

To all those who are watching, both here in our galleries and at home on our live broadcast: Welcome to your House of Representatives.

So, Members, let's build on our accomplishments. Let's get to work doing the people's business - in a timely manner. Short, sweet and complete.

Let's get in, get the job done, and get home.

It is our responsibility. It is our constitutional duty. And it's what our people sent us here to do.

Let's roll up our sleeves and let's get to work.

Speaker of the House, The Honorable Robbie Wills presented Governor Mike Beebe to the General Assembly.

Governor's Address

This is a historic day, one that provides a great lesson about our democracy and reminds us that our Constitution is a living document. Amendment 86, approved by the people of Arkansas, much to the surprise of many of us, established this fiscal sessions with a clear intent.

They wanted you to be brief, and they wanted you to deal with fiscal matters only, unless two-thirds of both houses approved a concurrent resolution for a non-budget bill. And we have the opportunity and responsibility to set the tone for future fiscal sessions by acknowledging the will of the people and keeping this session focused, brief, and on the budget.

There is one exception that we will address quickly: setting the amounts for the lottery scholarships.

As I've said, I agree with all of you that the State should award the largest scholarships possible to as many recipients as we can-including students currently in college.

While I am notoriously conservative about money, and while I would prefer to err on the side of being overly conservative, in this democracy that we have, I am willing and able, if you are convinced that we can make it, to go a little bit higher than my own conservative values would have suggested. This is with the caveat and the warning that it will be up to this legislature, every year, to look at the numbers and adjust those amounts accordingly. Keeping in mind, I hope, that once we establish a scholarship for a new student that we live with that amount and keep that faith throughout the four years of college for that student.

I've been saying for more than a year now that Arkansas is not immune from the effects of this international economic crisis. Times are tough for a lot of our people. Many have lost jobs; many more are worried about paying their bills.

But Arkansas remains in better fiscal shape than 47 of our sister states, and that it the direct result of your leadership. During this recession, we have lost 27,000 jobs, but we have announced 23,000 new jobs during the same period; and the Quick

Action Closing Fund, which you all created and you all have afforded this State, is part of the main reason that we've remained competitive in a tough economy and added even higher-paying jobs, in many instances, than the ones we have lost.

By the end of this year, you all, in conjunction with adding new jobs, will also have decreased taxes more than any legislature in any four-year period in the history of Arkansas, with more than \$500 million in tax cuts for the people of the State of Arkansas.

You made a series of unprecedented budget decisions last year that proved to be very wise, preserving our essential state services that have a real impact on Arkansans.

You put \$61 million in one-time money into this year's budget. Without this infusion, the cuts we have had to make this fiscal year would have been even deeper. You all know I don't like using one-time money for ongoing programs, but if you're ever going to do it, you do it on a rainy day. Why have a rainy-day fund if you're not going to use it for a rainy day?

In addition to that \$61 million, you created a \$40 million rainy-day fund for that same purpose, and trust me, it's being utilized and will be utilized in a way that will keep those essential services where they need to be.

Every one of our citizens needs to be constantly reminded, when we talk about cutting here and cutting there, that 95 cents out of every general revenue dollar goes to three places: education, human services, prisons - all essential for the welfare, education, and protection of our people. So when somebody says to take it from somebody, you ask which of those three you want to take it from. Ninety-five cents out of every dollar goes to those three critical services, and you all have kept the faith to keep all those things alive

Now, I want everyone to understand why, in relation to the rest of the country, why that's important.

California has laid-off 27,000 teachers, and has announced the release of 40,000 prisoners from state prisons in an effort to reduce a \$20-billion budget deficit. They're trying to make up some of that. Listen to this: running a red light in Los Angeles now costs you \$446. The reason it's an odd number is because when you add whatever the cost is to go to driving school and keep it off your record or get it

off faster, it comes to an even \$500. Can you imagine what Arkansans would say about \$500 for running a red light?

Michigan furloughed 38,000 state employees. Georgia just announced more furloughs for all 250,000 state employees, including teachers.

Because of you, Arkansas has not laid off a single teacher. In fact, you all have increased funding for schools. We haven't been forced into massive releases of prisoners in our penitentiaries, as I referenced was done in California. Your foresight and your commitment to fiscal discipline have helped to spare Arkansans from the financial disaster that so many other states are currently experiencing.

But what's more important is that you've ensured that Arkansas is prepared to emerge from this recession in better shape than nearly every other state in America. If you'll think about it, most of those states, which have used their stimulus money just to keep from having to fire more people than they've already fired, are in a position, when that one-time stimulus money is gone, they're going to be saddled with trying to come up with their regular budget just to keep their people employed. You didn't spend your stimulus money for that purpose. You spent one-time money on one-time purposes, and that's what it should be spent for. You spent it to create jobs, and spent it in such a way that, when that one-time money is gone, you won't have to try and find some other money just to keep people employed. You've already taken care of them, too. And, as we continue with the theme of setting a precedent with our first-ever fiscal session, I want you to remain as fiscally astute and as conservative and as aware as you have been, going forward.

A general revenue budget of \$4.5 billion that my administration has presented for your consideration restores this year's budget cuts, but that's all. It keeps everything else flat. All of us, I recommend, suffer together.

We have critical needs that have to be addressed, not the least of which are Medicaid, children and family services, youth services, health-information technology, the Departments of Correction and Community Correction, and disaster preparedness and response. And most of all, not forgetting our top priority, yesterday, today, and tomorrow, will be education. It will always be the cornerstone to allow our people their share of the American Dream.

Oh, by the way, recent newspaper and television accounts have suggested the success of your program to put defibrillators in our schools. We need very little money to continue doing that so we can save kids' lives in those catastrophic instances.

We have to preserve jobs, particularly in our smaller agencies that don't have the ability to make up for some of these losses because they don't have vacant positions or a lot of employee turnover that can absorb those things.

We have to make sure we pay our county jails. Incidentally, we're already out of money for this fiscal year, so we have to be able to reimburse our counties for our county jails. We have to be able to pay the bills that come into our State, and we have to address these and other issues, so that we can continue down the path that we've been going down better than most of the country.

Now, you've given me extraordinary authority in the past 12 months. I have to tell you, I would never, ever overreach. Those of you who know me well know that I sat where you sit. I sat as a member of the Senate and as a member of the General Assembly, and I dealt with a lot of governors. Some I agreed with, some I disagreed with; more often than not both applied to every governor. One of the things that I don't ever want to happen is, if in our disagreements, and it's healthy to have them, that we have those disagreements based upon something I've done to breach the trust and understanding and cooperation in the relationship between the legislative branch and the executive branch. I am a product of the legislative branch. At the risk of immodesty, I will tell you that I don't think there will be a governor, or ever has been a governor, who appreciates and understands and respects the legislative branch more than I do. Whatever we do going forward, I want us to remember that.

Because a whole lot of the reason we've had the success that we've had, a whole lot of the reason the rest of the country is talking about Arkansas in a favorable light, is because of that cooperation, that trust, and that working together between the legislative branch of the State of Arkansas and the governor's office.

So in an effort to keep the theme of this session what you all want it to be, short and sweet, I'm going to leave it with you and tell you that my door is open and always has been. You are invited, and most of you have availed yourself of that invitation, at anytime. If there are people waiting, if there are cabinet heads or agency heads waiting in the lobby, they know to wait until the members of the General Assembly

who are there to see me, have their chance to come in and say whatever they have to say. If you have to wait, it's usually because I'm talking to one of your colleagues already.

So let's go forth to serve this State we love, and let's do the things we need to do to ensure that the progress we've made is built upon, and that the people of Arkansas are served by the people they've elected into these respected offices. Let's remember that the people trust you, they believe in you, and the most sacred thing we have is that trust of the people. God bless you all, let's go to work.
