D) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The board ensures consumers of home inspection services can rely upon the competence of home inspectors as determined by educational and testing requirements. The board issues licenses, renewals, and resolves disciplinary matters as provided by law. The board is composed of seven members appointed by the Governor.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The biennial budget totals \$51,090 the first year and \$46,090 the second year of the biennium.

FUNDING SOURCE

Funds are derived from Home Inspector License fees and deposited into the State Treasury in the Arkansas Home Inspectors Registration Fund.

II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

Increases of \$18,000 FY10 and \$13,000 FY11 to include operating increases of \$12,000 each year for contracted administrative support and \$6,000 the first year and \$1,000 the second for the costs of investigations.

Act 104 of 2009 Supplemental to Act 499 of 2007, provides an additional \$12K of appropriation for various operation expenses. To provide for the increase in the board's administrative support services contract, from \$24K to \$36K in FY09
