**EXECUTIVE RECOMMENDATION**

**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES**

**MISSION**

The Commission is responsible for establishing minimum standards for the selection and training of law enforcement officers in Arkansas. The Commission provides basic training for new officers and specialized training for certified police officers at the ALETA training academy near East Camden, while also providing field training classes across the state.

**TOTAL APPROPRIATION**

The total budget is \$3,686,506 each year of the biennium.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The Commission is funded primarily from general revenues from the miscellaneous agencies fund, with the remainder financed by federal grants and cash funds.

**II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS**

Operations - increase of \$22K each year for food costs and sales tax.

Special Training - increase of \$131K each year for tuition costs and the purchase of kitchen equipment.

Discontinue the Drug Detection Training Federal Appropriation.
