SECTION 37. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain recent amendments to the Internal Revenue Code have not been adopted into Arkansas's income tax law; that these inconsistencies make it difficult for Arkansas taxpayers and their tax preparers to report and remit the correct amount of Arkansas income tax; and that this act is immediately necessary to facilitate the orderly administration of Arkansas's income tax laws. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
