I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Department of Rural Services serves as a single contact point for local governments, state and federal agencies, and other private and non-profit organizations and individuals with an interest in the rural policies and programs of the state. The Arkansas Rural Development Commission oversees the functions and duties of the agency. The Agency and the Commission strive to enhance the quality of life for rural Arkansans by providing resources necessary to help themselves succeed in their community.

TOTAL BUDGET

The budget is \$ \$2,581,767 for FY2015.

FUNDING SOURCE

The budget is funded by general revenues and cash derived from fees charged to conference participants and donations received through corporate sponsorship.

IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE

* General Improvement Projects Administrative Fee. Rural Services is authorized to retain and utilize 1% of the total amount of any General Improvement Fund moneys received for projects authorized to be disbursed.

* Fund Transfer. Establishes the transfer of the 1% General Improvement Fund moneys to the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account for the administrative fee.

* Carry Forward. Unexpended balance of funds transferred into the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account for administration of general improvement fund projects shall remain and be made available for the same purpose during the following year.

* County Fair Grants. Rural Services shall develop rules and regulations for disbursement of the funds. The grants are to be matched 50/50 with no county receiving more than \$30,000 for the biennium.

* Grant Award Criteria. The Office of Rural Services shall promulgate regulations to determine how grants are to be disbursed subject to approval of the Governor and approval of the ALC or Joint Budget Committee.
