<u>SB13</u>	Standridge (House)	TO CLARIFY WORKERS' COMPENSATION DEATH AND PERMANENT TOTAL DISABILITY TRUST PAYMENTS UNDER THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW THAT RESULTED FROM INITIATED MEASURE 1948, NO.4; AND TO LOWER EMPLOYERS' TAX RATE.
