**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES**

**MISSION**

The Office of the Prosecutor Coordinator was created in 1975 by Act 925, A.C.A. 16-21-201. The Prosecution Coordination Commission, a seven member board chosen by elected prosecuting attorneys, sets the overall policy of the Coordinator's Office. The office provides a broad range of technical assistance and support services for prosecuting attorneys, their deputies, and support staff. They have the following main program areas: Legal Research, Continuing Legal Education, Lending Library, Publications, Civil Commitments, Victim/Witness, and Computers.

**TOTAL APPROPRIATION**

The total appropriation is \$1,106,734 for FY2018 and FY2019.

**FUNDING SOURCES**

The Office of Prosecutor Coordinator operations appropriation is funded from the State Central Services Fund. The Office also receives transfers from the State Administration of Justice Fund for the Law Enforcement and Prosecutorial Programs appropriation.
