I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Board was created by Act 1588 of 1999 and 1708 of 2001 to provide regulatory authority over persons who hold themselves out to the public as Licensed Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counselors. The Board is responsible for establishing licensure and certification requirements, defining and promoting the practice of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counselors, setting the standards of qualifications, training, and experience for those who engage in the practice, and maintaining an office.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation is \$31,966 for fiscal years 2018 and 2019, a continuation of Base Level.

FUNDING SOURCE

This agency's one appropriation is cash funded with licensing/renewal fees generated by the boards' operations.
