I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Arkansas Fire Protection Licensing Board certifies and licenses individuals and companies that install and service fire extinguishers and sprinkler systems. The Board seeks to protect and promote public safety by minimizing personal injury and property damage which might result from improperly installed or maintained fire protection systems. The Board is composed of eleven (11) members who are appointed by the Governor for terms of five (5) years. The Fire Protection Licensing Board was created in 1977

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation for the Board is \$271,452 for FY2018 and \$248,078 for FY2019.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Board is funded by cash funds through examination, licensure, certification and renewal fees.

II) CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS

FIRE PROTECTION OPERATIONS

This appropriation is funded by examination and renewal fees charged by the Board and is used to pay for board operations. The total appropriation for FY2018 is \$271,452, an increase of \$43,100 from base level. The Total appropriation for FY2019 is \$248,078, an increase of \$19,276 from base level.

Increases are to the operating expenses line item for each year for a postage meter, mileage for the investigator, and membership dues. Additional increases are added to FY2018 for an update to the Access Database licensing system.
