**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES**

**MISSION**

The Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission enforces the Federal Manufactured Home Construction and Safety Standards and the Federal Manufactured Home Procedural and Enforcement Regulations. The Commission requires manufacturers and dealers to be certified with the Commission. Installers and salespersons must be licensed with the Commission. The Commission is also charged with monitoring manufactured home dealer lots and to act as a consumer protection agency which handles consumer complaints relating to structural defects in the home and the blocking or anchoring of manufactured homes.

**TOTAL APPROPRIATION**

The total appropriation for the Commission is \$462,722 for FY2018 and \$462,722 for FY2019.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The Commission is funded through Special & Federal Revenues from fees charged to dealers, manufacturers, and installers.
