

ARKANSAS CEMETERY BOARD (AGENCY 0218)

I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Cemetery Board, established by legislation, inspects and administers the issuance of permits to perpetual care cemeteries (municipal, church, family and non-profit community cemeteries). The Board is empowered to provide the funding necessary to make loans to a court appointed receiver or conservator to help assure that a cemetery placed in receivership will be properly maintained and continue to be a viable operation.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation is \$129,261.

FUNDING SOURCES

The Board is funded by Cash Funds from fees collected through permits, amended permits, and examination of cemeteries.

Per Act 788 of 2017, this Board was transferred by type 3 transfer to the State Department of Insurance. The Board was abolished and its powers and duties transferred to the State Insurance Department. The Act created a new "State Board of Embalmers, Funeral Directors, Cemeteries and Burial Services".
