Ladies and Gentlemen:

The purpose of this memorandum is to update the Task Force on activity undertaken by our team as part of the Health Information Management Consulting Services. Our goal is to deliver our initial report and presentation to the Task Force at the April meeting.

DATA GATHERING AND VALIDATION PHASE – 75% Complete

Since the last Task Force meeting, Chairman Hendren instructed Mark Hudson to draft a memo to all school districts instructing them to provide hours worked information directly to Collier Insurance. As of March 10, 2014, Collier has received 30% of the districts representing 23,863 employees.

As a backup plan, we had a conference call with representatives of the Department of Education on March 5, 2014 to discuss what assumptions could be made regarding Hours Worked and Benefit Eligibility based on Job Title, Function Code and Part Time/Full Time indicators.

APRIL TASK FORCE MEETING – April 16, 2014
