A. New Interim Study Proposals and Interim Resolutions:

1. **Interim Resolution 2025-004, by Representative DeAnn Vaught and Senator Clarke Tucker**, requesting that the Legislative Council respectfully urge President Donald J. Trump to implement targeted relief for Arkansas farmers in 2025.
2. **Interim Study Proposal 2025-081, by Senator Steve Crowell**, is to prohibit insurance companies and appraisers from requiring an insured to use certain facilities to repair or replace damaged motor vehicle safety glass; and to provide penalties for violations.
