Insert an additional SECTION immediately following SECTION 10 of the bill to read as follows:

" SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. RESPONSE TO SHORTAGE OR REDUCTION OF AVAILABLE FUNDS. (a)(1) If the Department of Human Services elects to terminate employees or eliminate employment positions due to a shortage or reduction of funds available to the department:

(A) At least one-half (1/2) of the terminated employees shall be from management positions that do not interact with the public as a primary function of the employment; and

(B) At least one-half (1/2) of the eliminated employment positions shall be management positions for which interaction with the public is not a primary function of the employment.

(2) Subsection (a) of this section does not prohibit the department from terminating an employee or eliminating an employment position for reasons other than a shortage or reduction of funds available to the department.

(3) Subsection (a) of this section does not apply if the shortage or reduction of funds available to the department results from a decrease in funding by the General Assembly.

(b) The department shall not eliminate or reduce funding for foster care services or juvenile detention services solely on the basis of a shortage or reduction of funds available to the department.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013."

5 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INTER-
7 AGENCY TRANSFER OF STATE GENERAL REVENUE FOR THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR

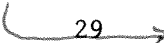
