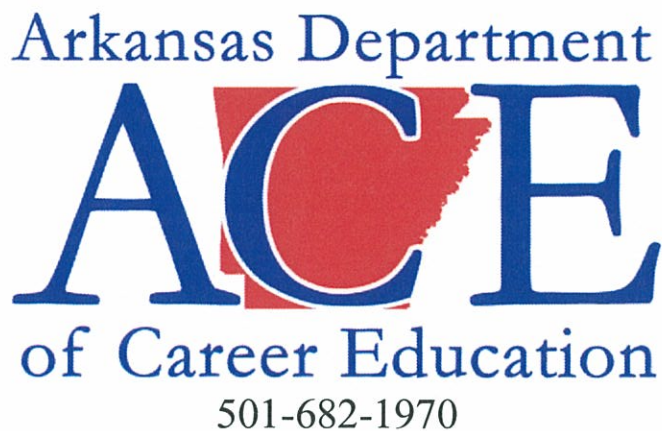

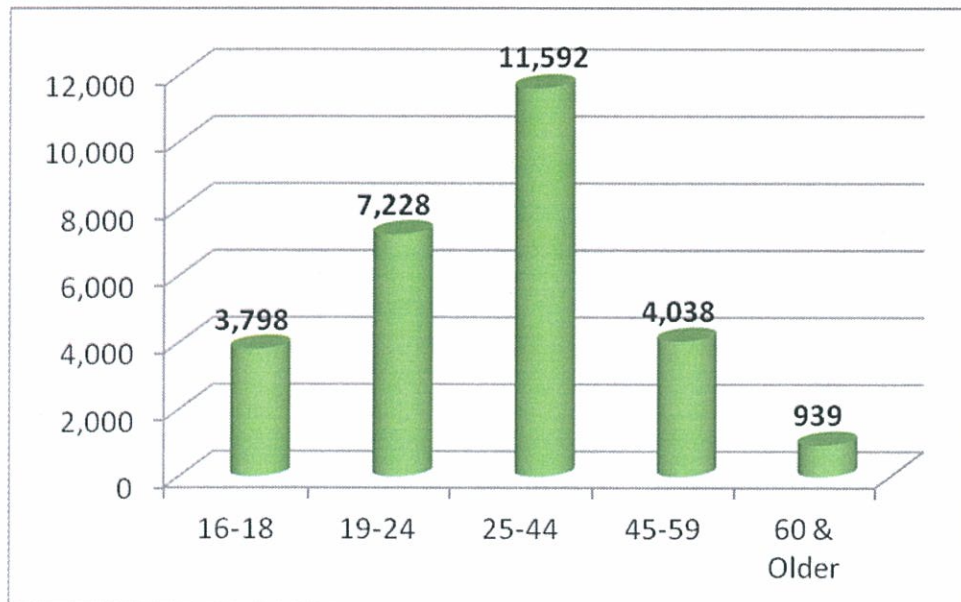

## ◆ Who are the adult education students in Arkansas?

- **44,475 students were served in adult education/literacy programs**
- **27,595 of those students were enrolled for 12 or more hours of instruction**

42% of enrolled adult education and literacy students were between 25 and 44 years old

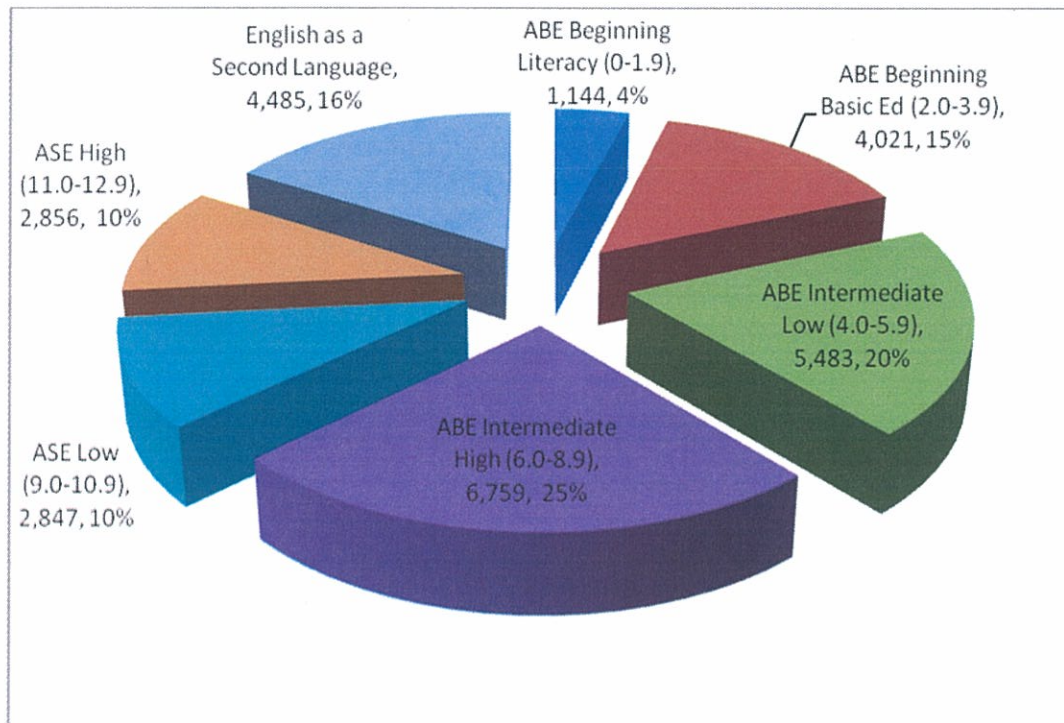

44% of all students were functioning between the 4th and 8th grade level

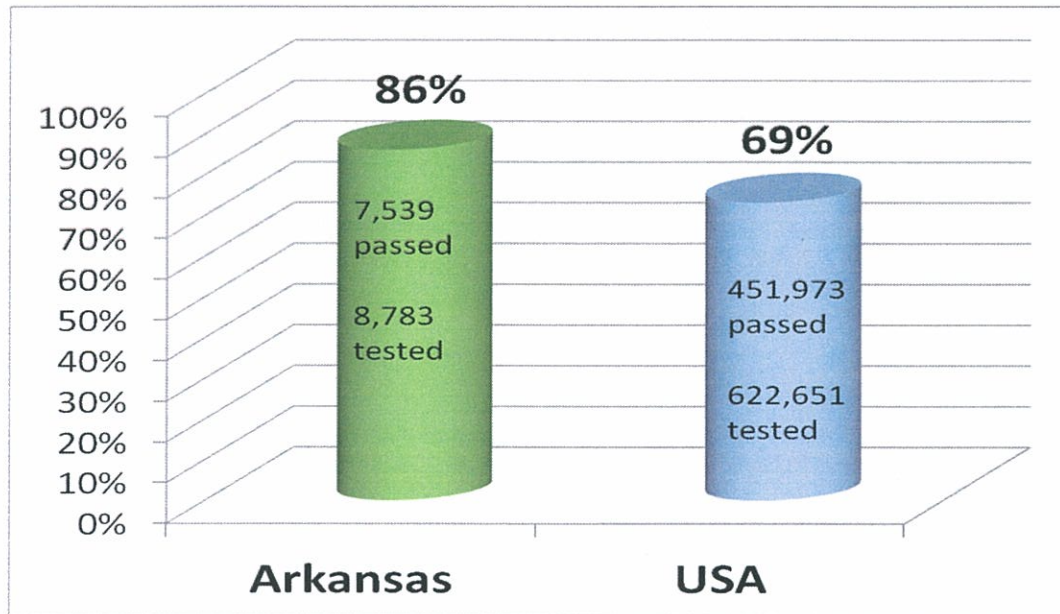
20% of all students were preparing for the GED tests

16% of all students were learning English as a Second Language

### ◆ What educational gains did Adult Education/Literacy students make in Arkansas?

- 77% of the enrolled students who took *both the pretest and the post-test made educational gains of one or more grade level equivalents*
- This equals 10,896 enrolled students who completed one or more grade level equivalents

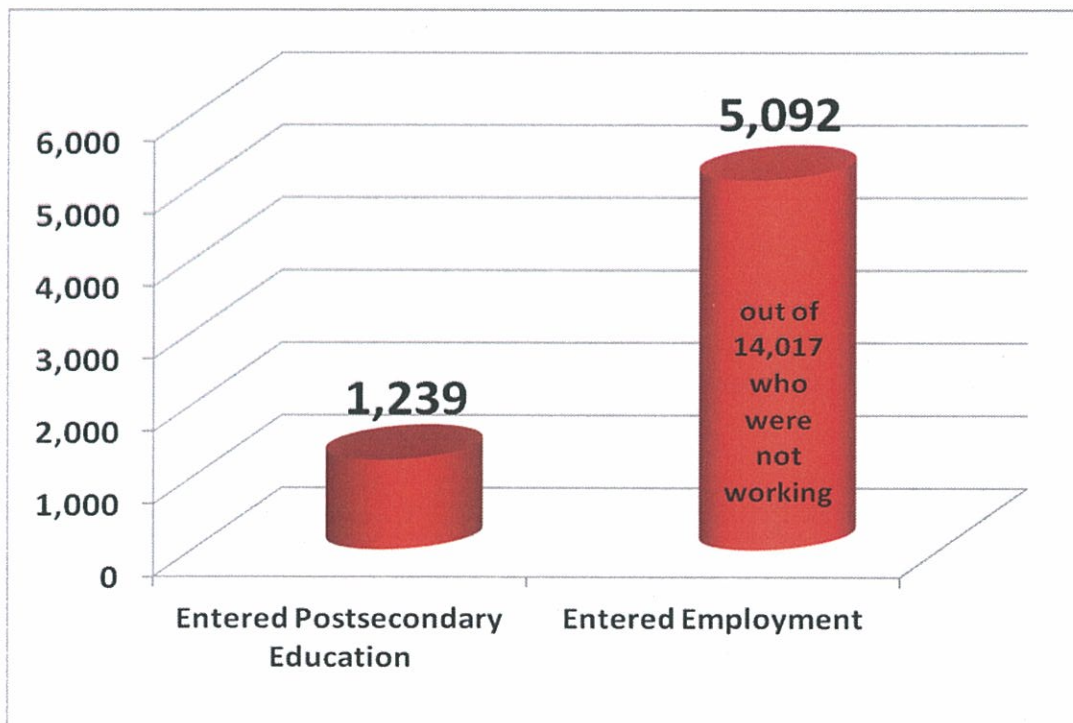
◆ How many Arkansans passed the General Educational Development (GED®) Tests in 2010?

**The Arkansas GED test pass rate is consistently higher than the national average pass rate.**

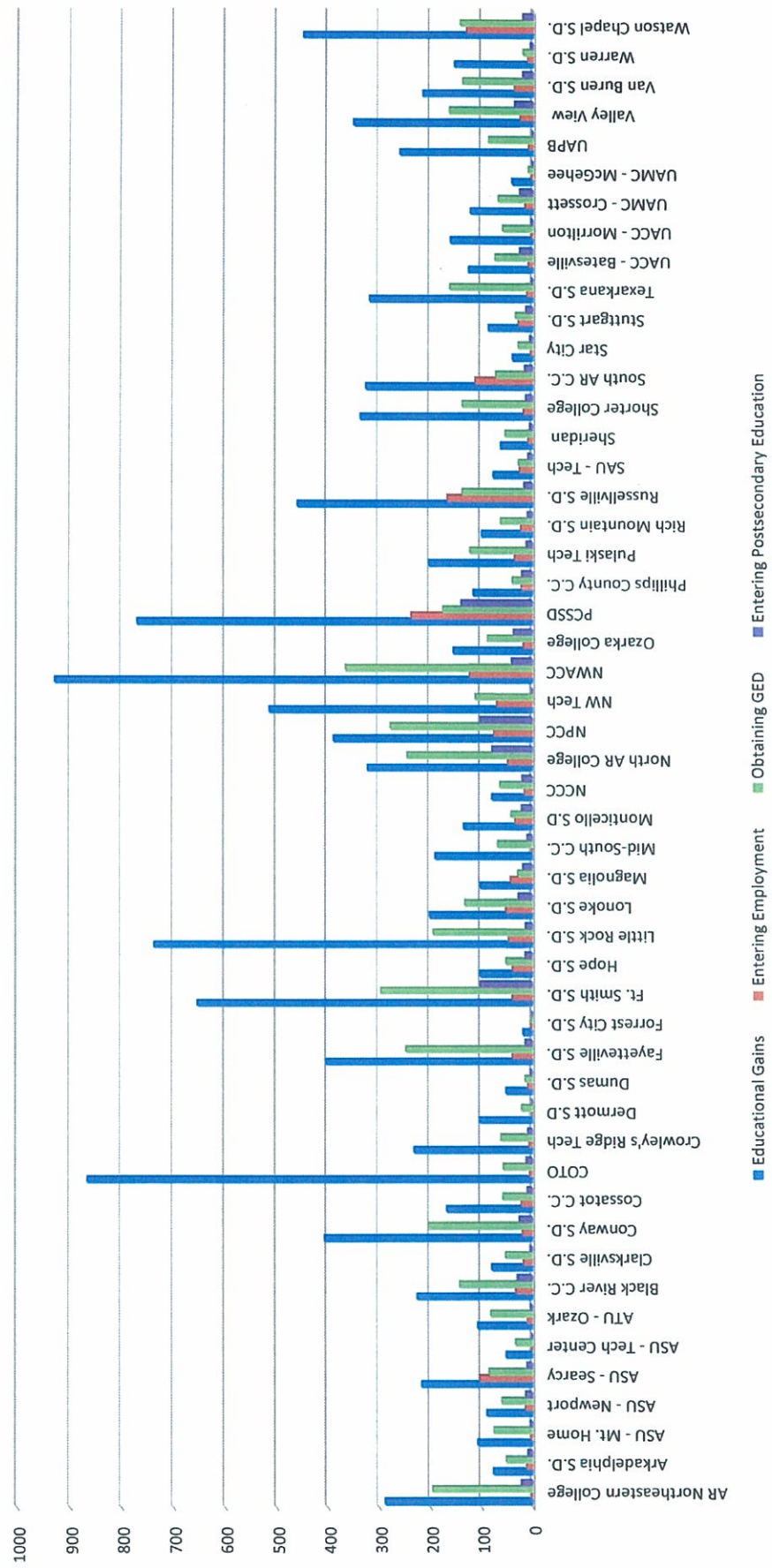

**5,092 unemployed students obtained jobs in the first three months after exiting adult education and literacy programs.**

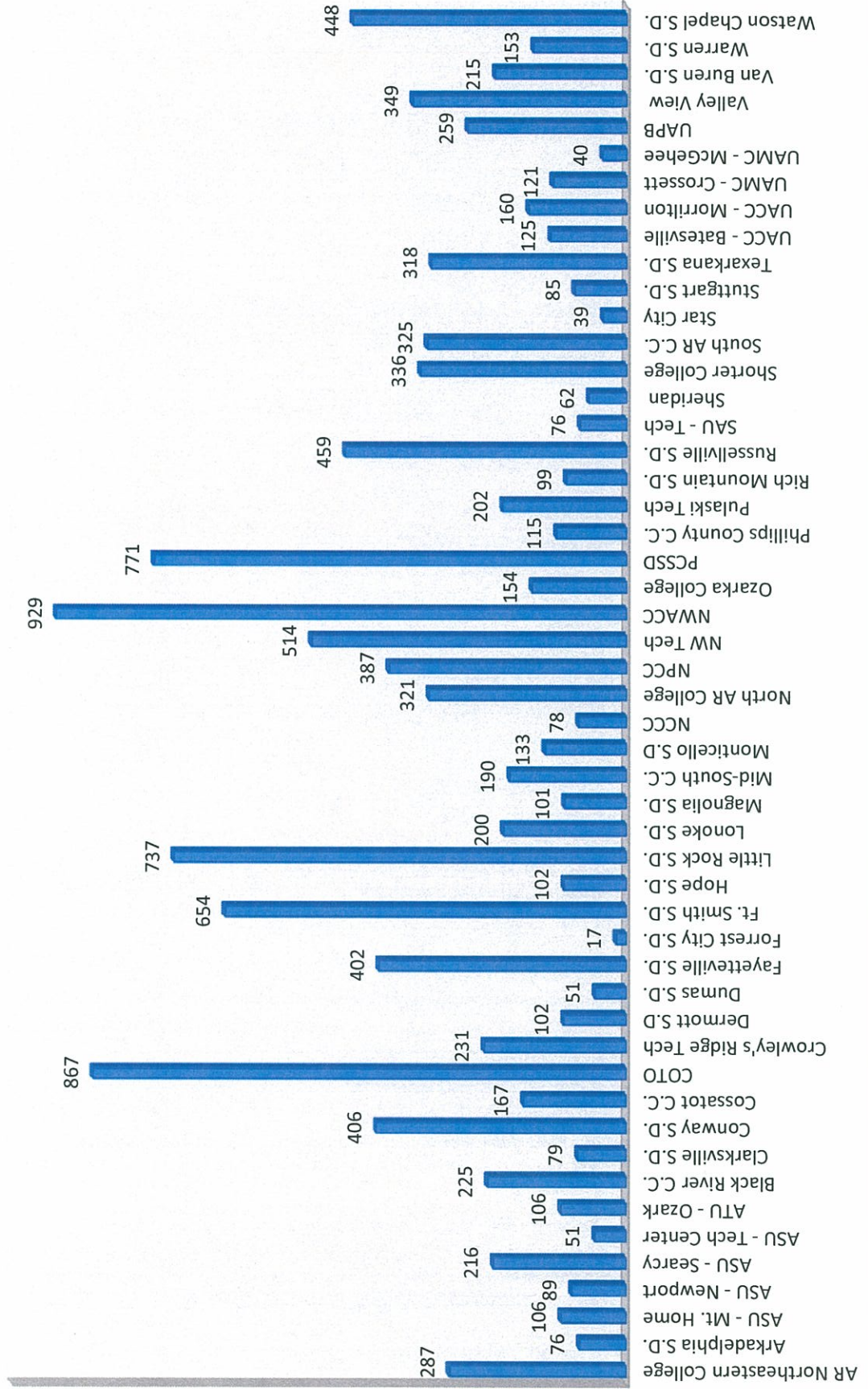
**1,239 adult education graduates entered postsecondary education after exiting.**

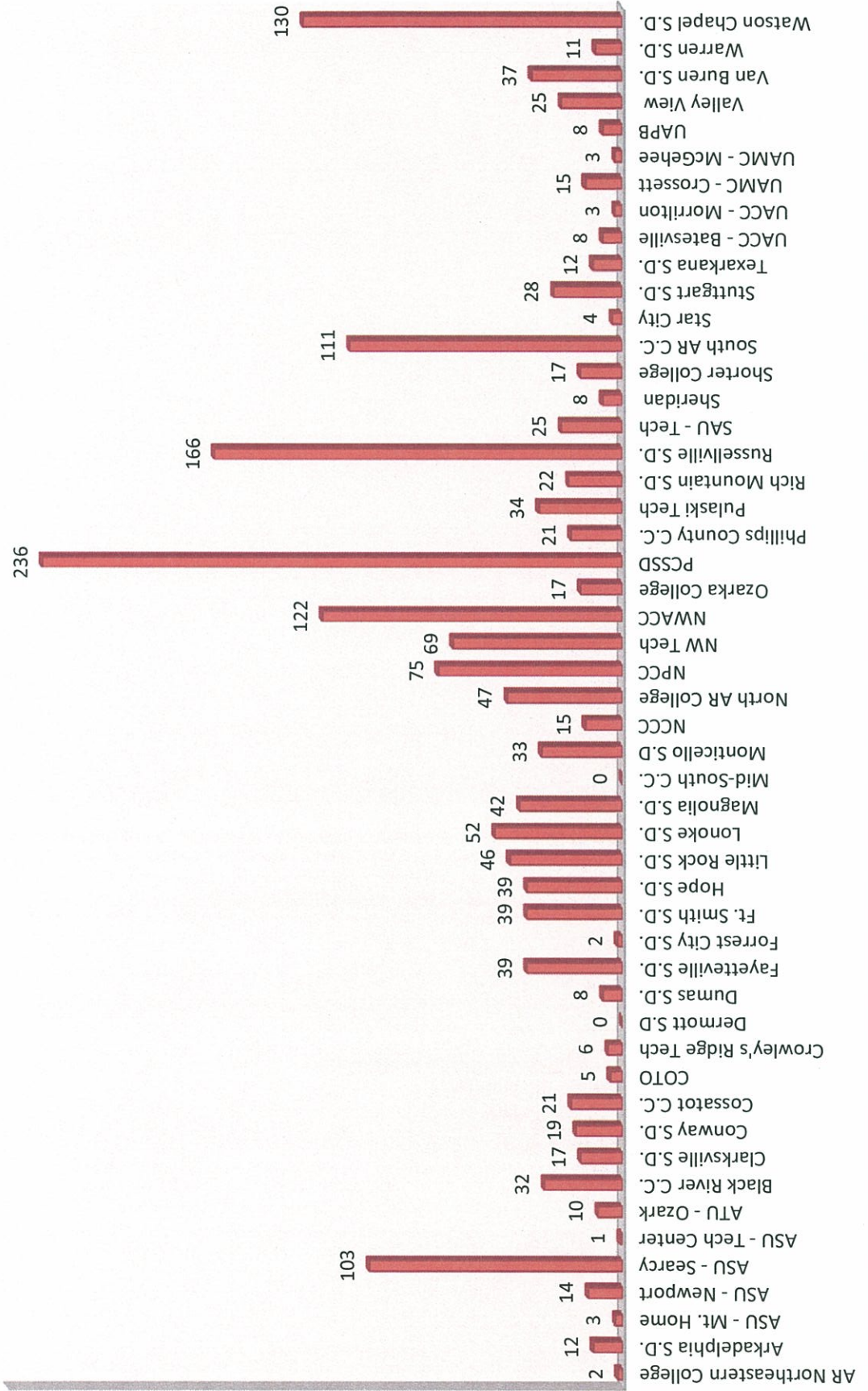

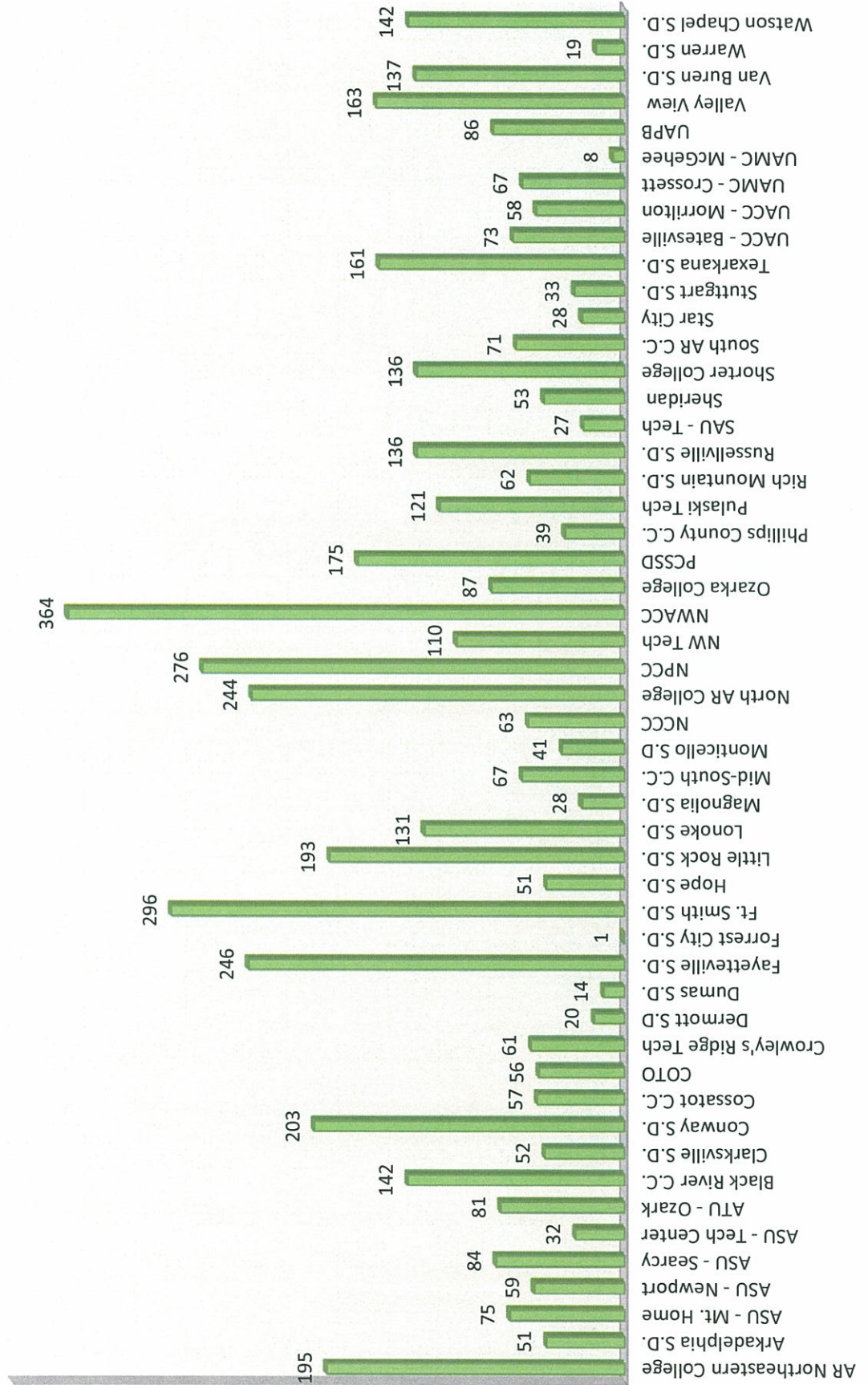
# 2009-2010 Adult Education Students Entering Employment

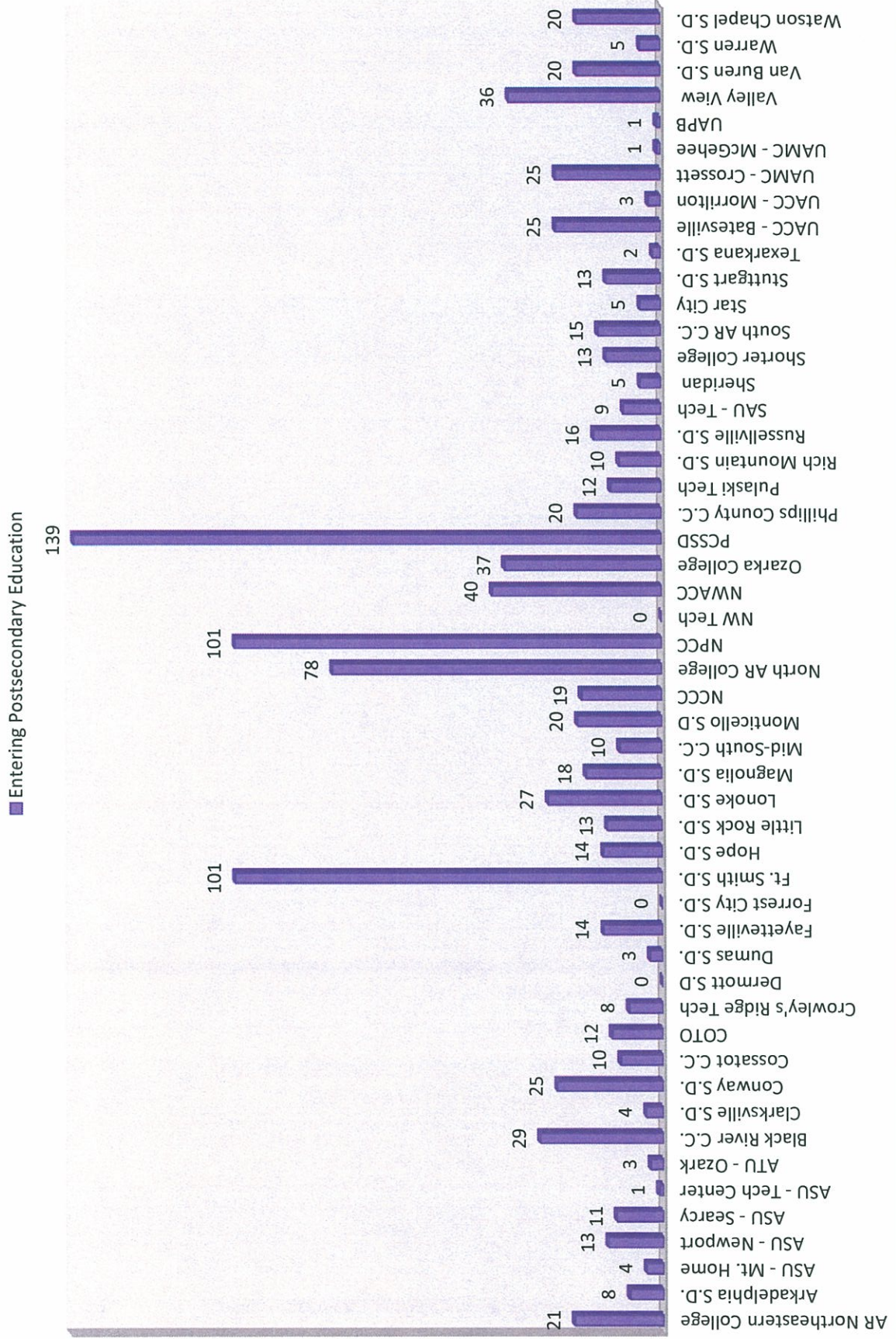

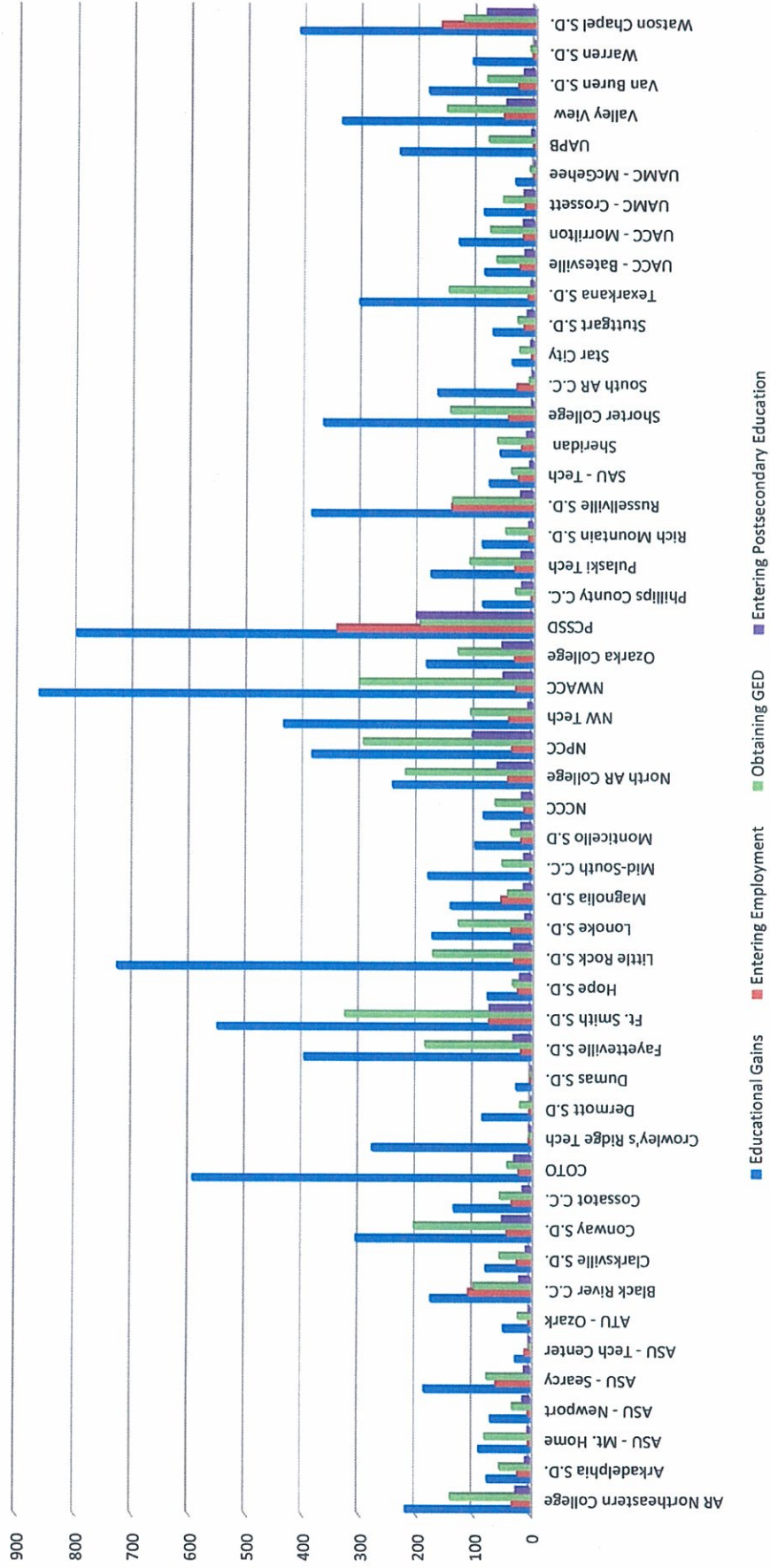




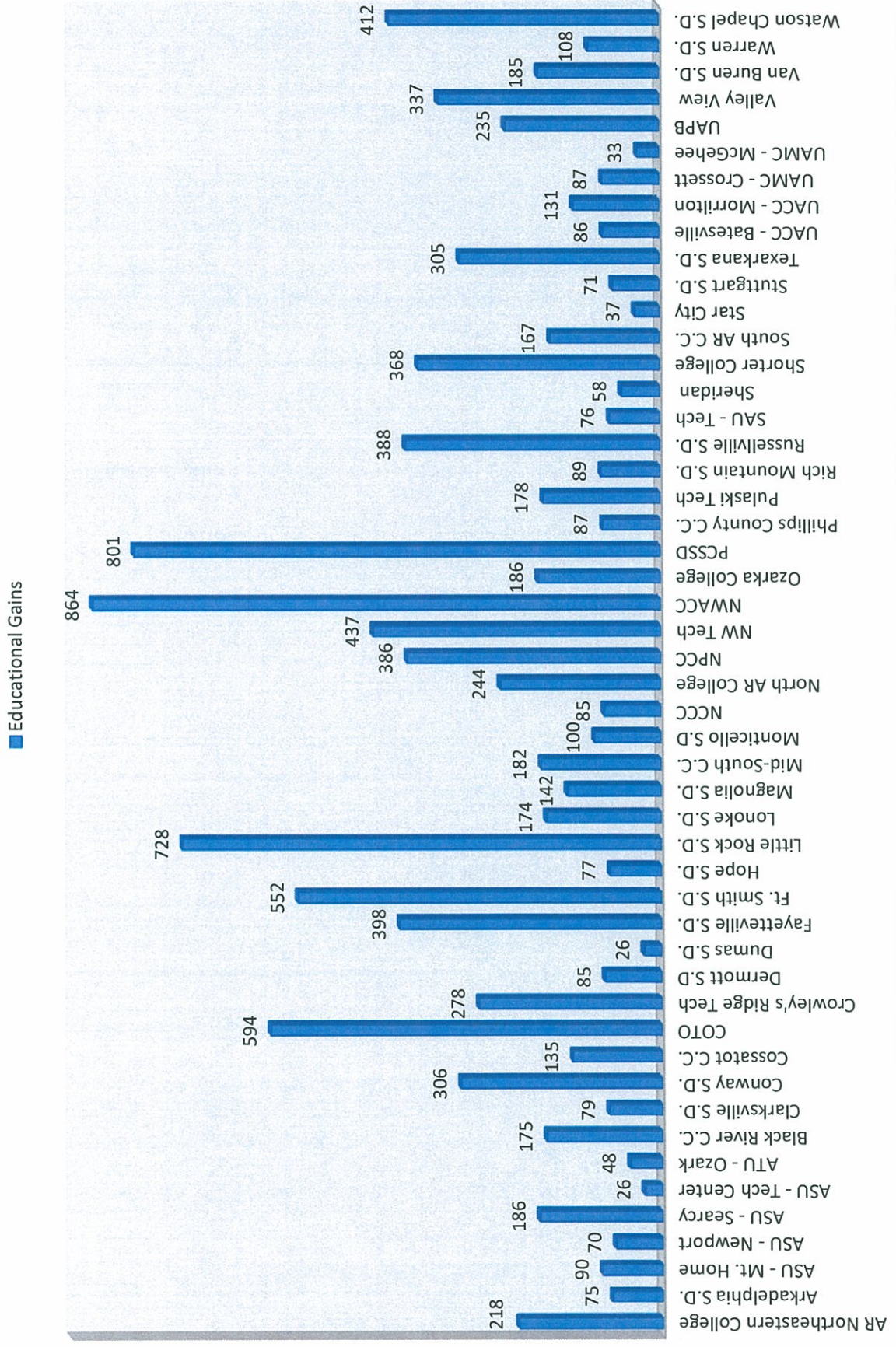
# 2009-2010 Adult Education Students Entering Postsecondary Education



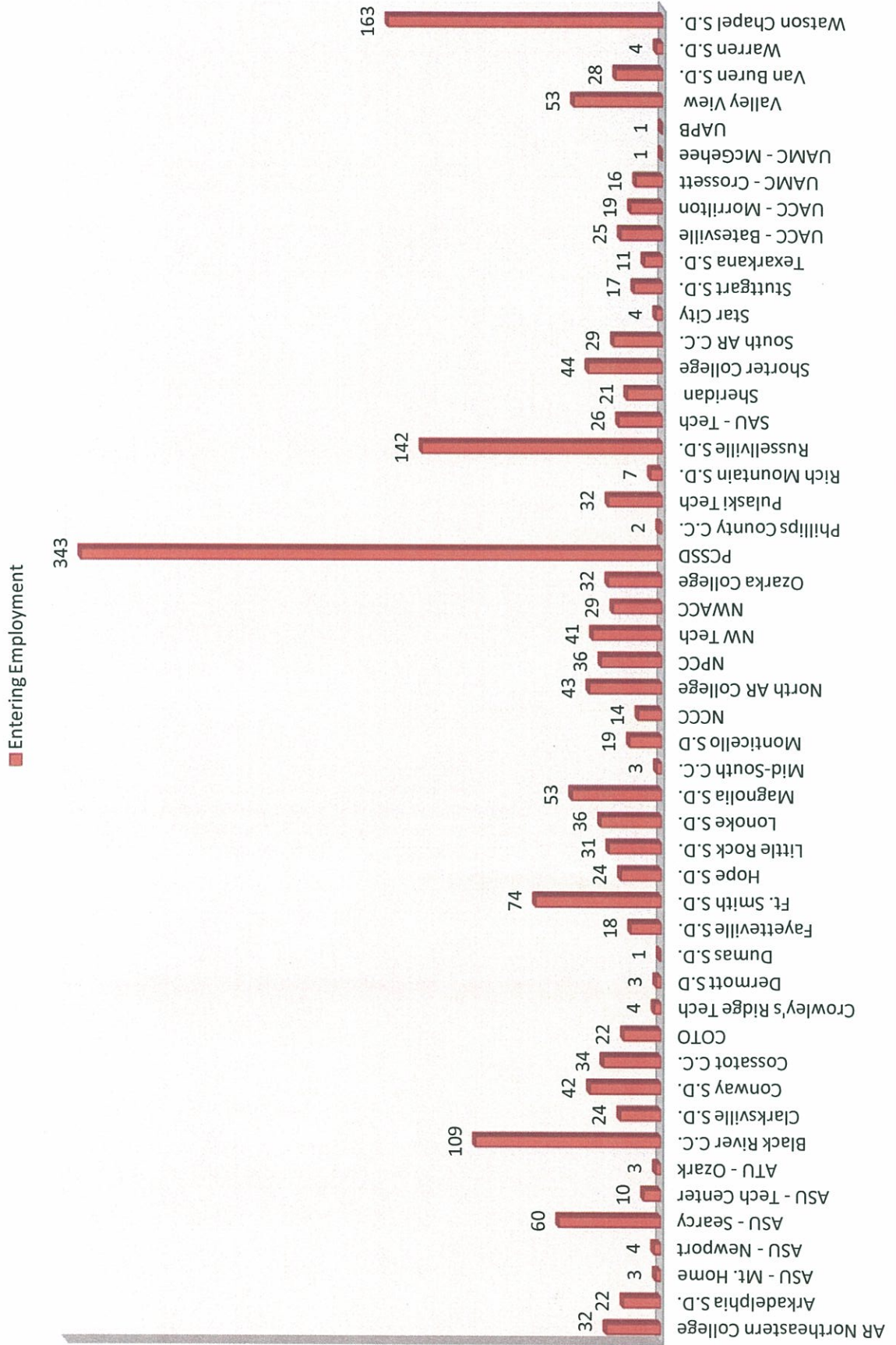
## 2010-2011 Adult Education Measure of Educational Gains and Outcomes

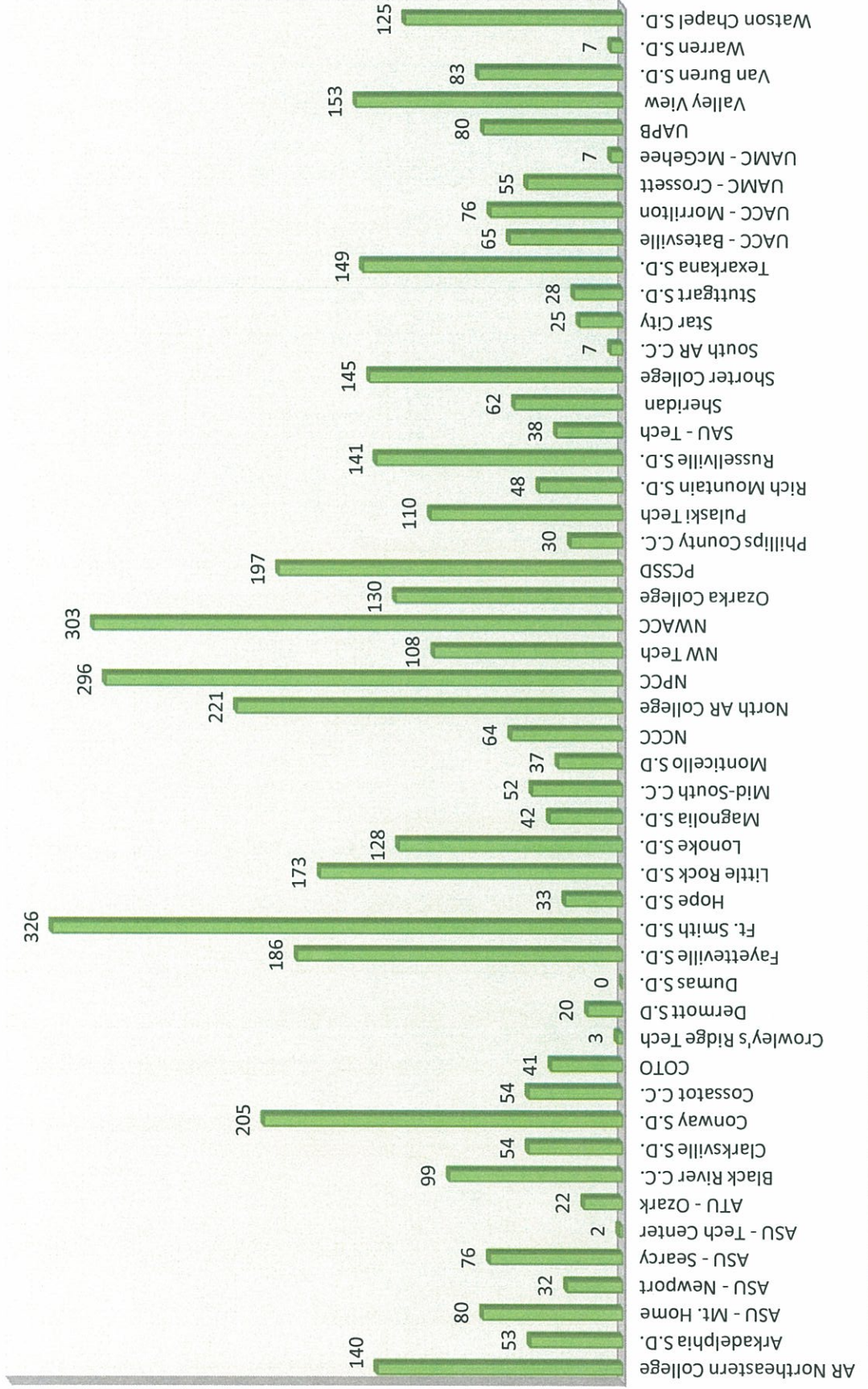

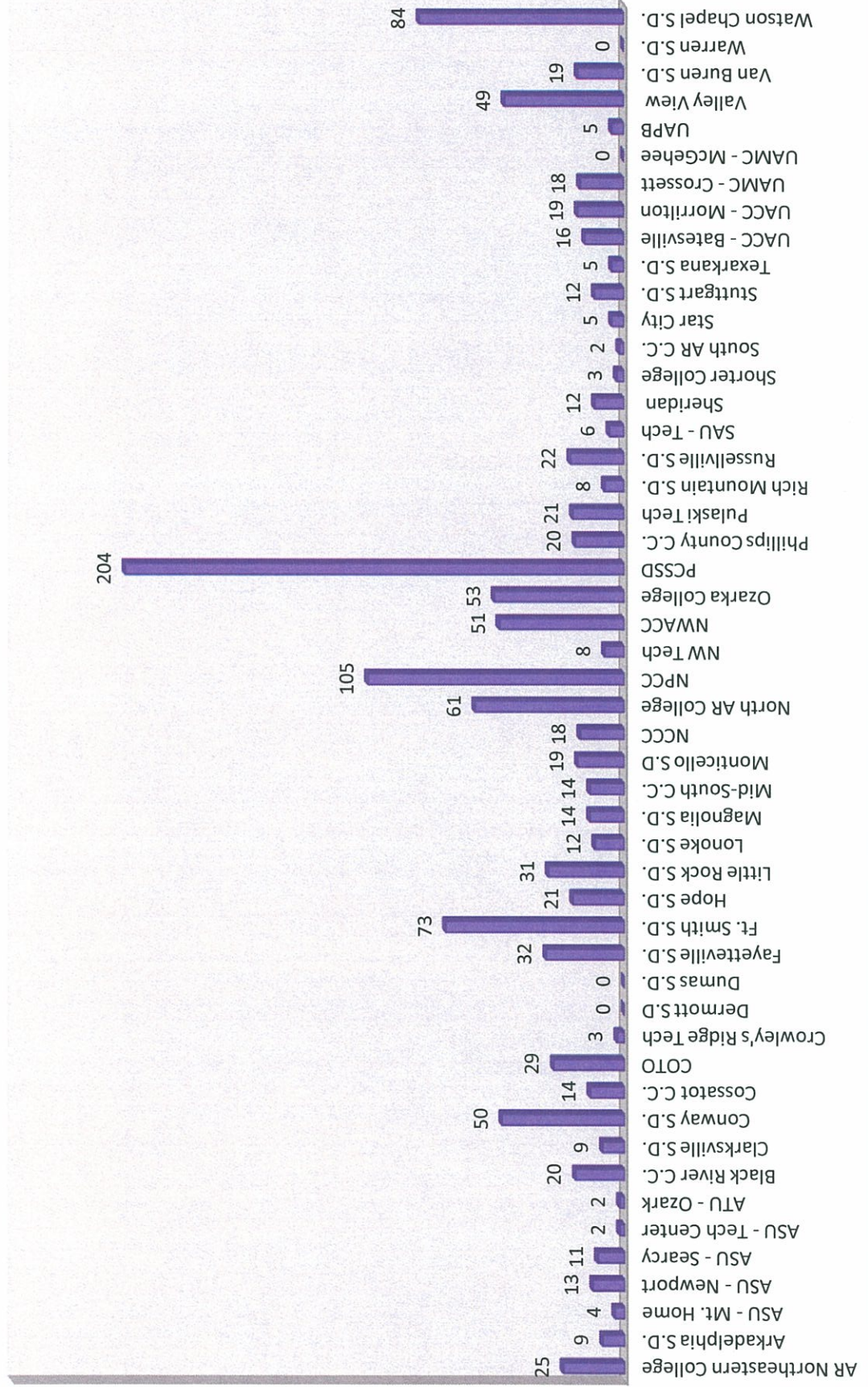

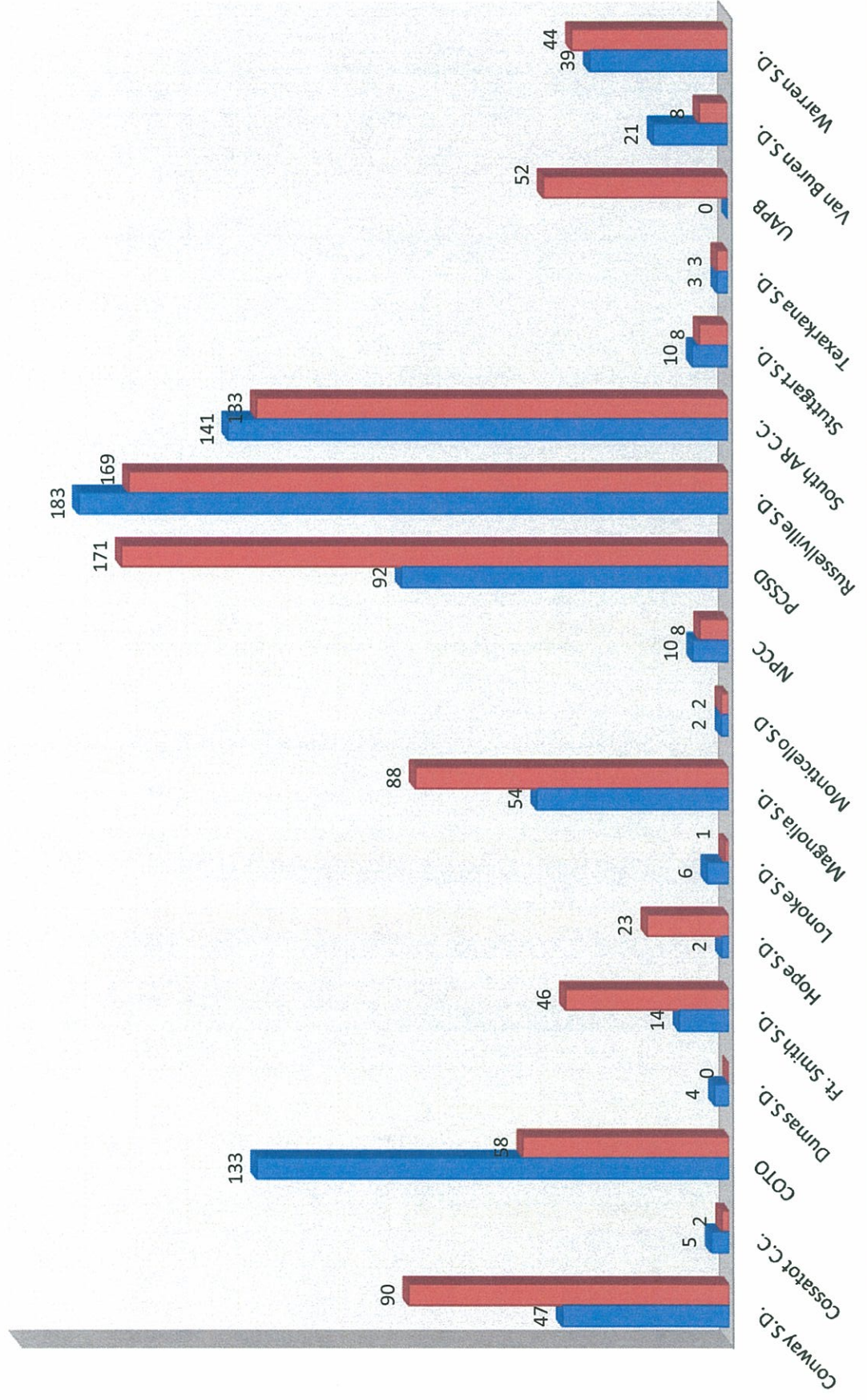
# 2010-2011 Adult Education Students Entering Postsecondary Education

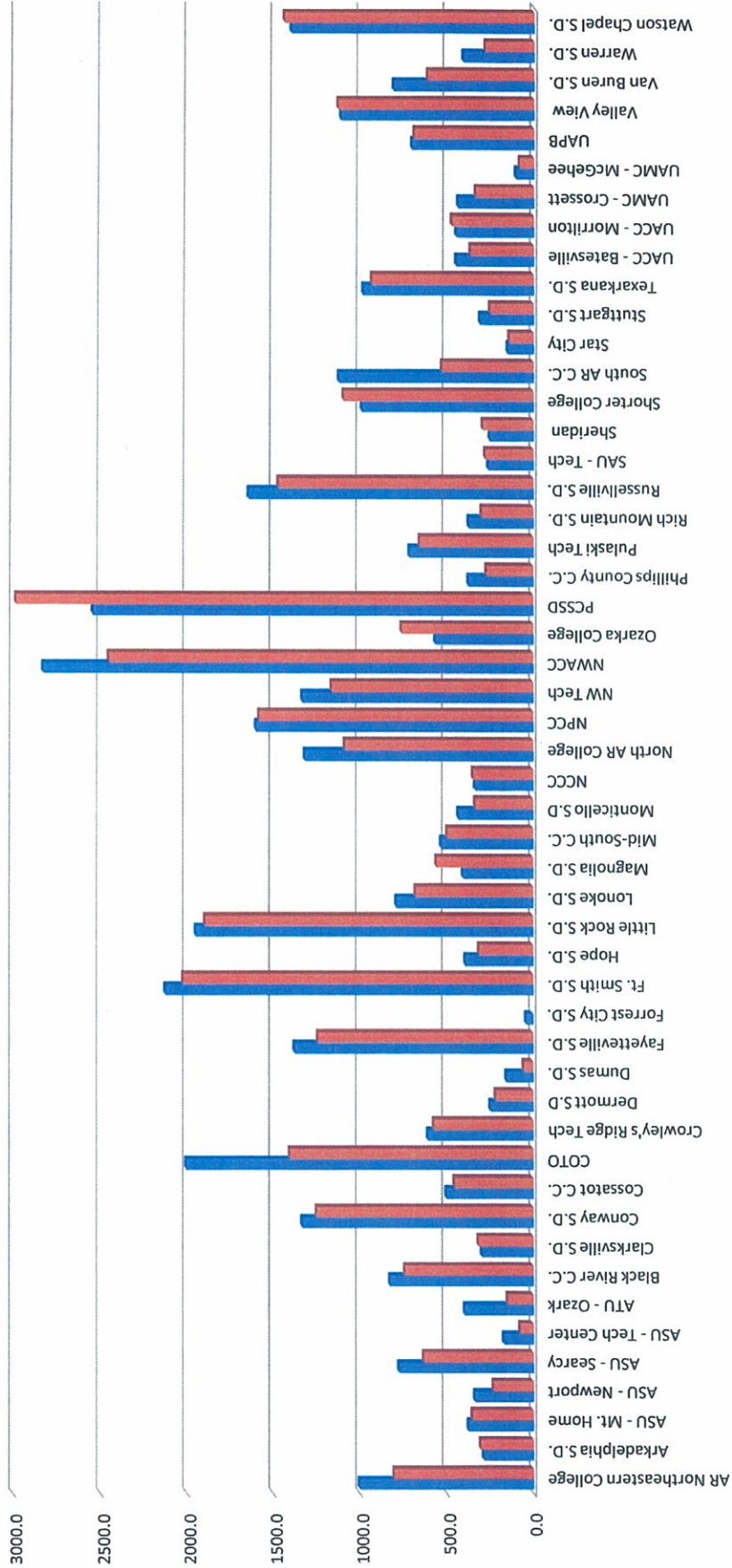


# Adult Education Students Earning WAGE Certificates
