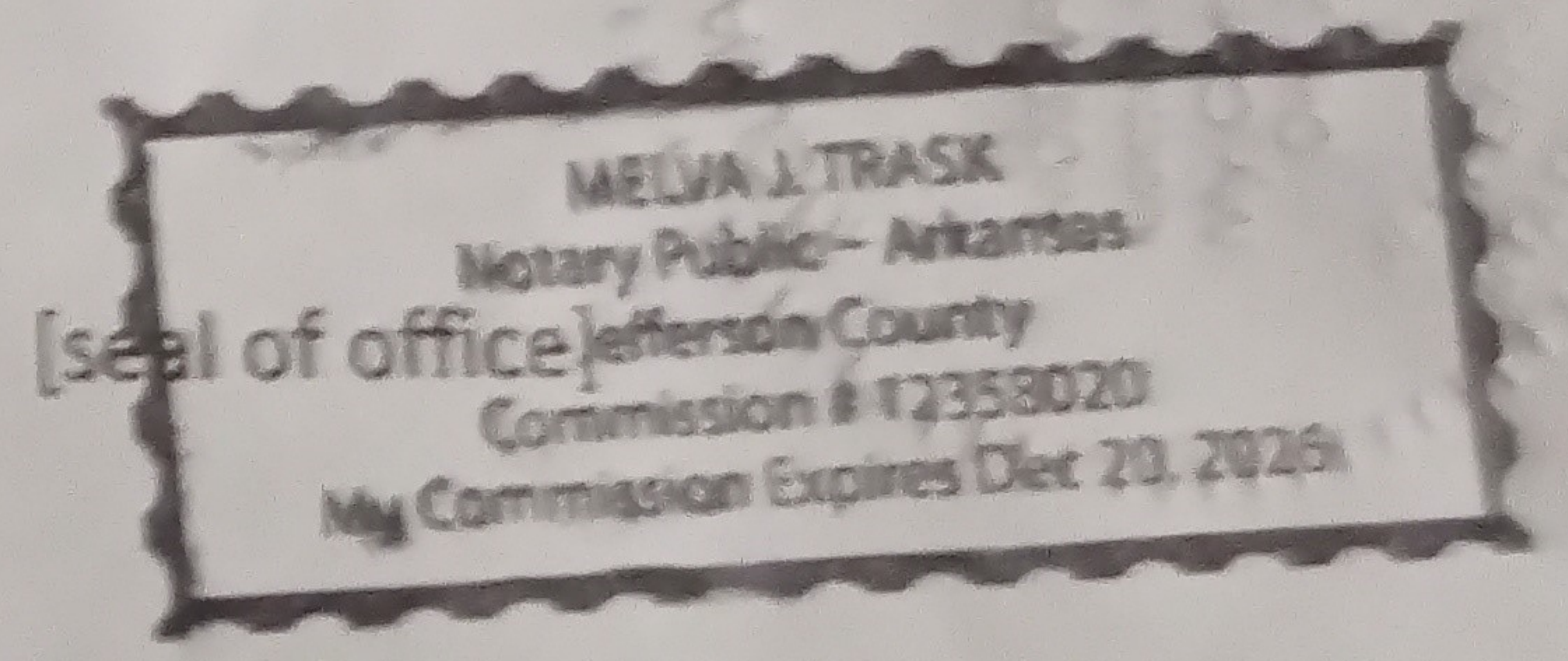

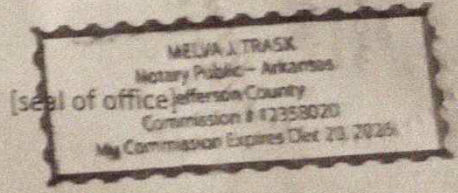

ANSWER AND MOTION TO DISMISS

Comes the Respondent, State of Arkansas, Department of Human Services (“DHS”), by its attorney, Abbey Trussell, and for its Answer and Motion to Dismiss states:

1. Respondent denies liability for claim 250621. Claimant’s parental rights were terminated effective February 20, 2024. *See* Exhibit 1, redacted. Claimant has no standing to bring this action nor does this Commission does not have jurisdiction over such an action.

2. Claimant has failed to state a claim upon which relief may be granted, as required by the Arkansas Rules of Civil Procedure. Ark. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6).

3. The Claim seeks “reunification and personal needs supports and an injunction for protection.” Upon information and belief, Claimant is referring to the dependency and neglect action which ultimately resulted in the termination of her parental rights as stated above. This action was fully litigated and adjudicated before the Juvenile Court in [REDACTED].

4. Claimant is precluded from bringing these claims by both the doctrines of *res judicata* and collateral estoppel. All claims regarding DHS, the dependency neglect investigation, and reunification/rehabilitation were addressed and resolved before the Juvenile Court.

5. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 9-27-306(a)(B) the circuit [juvenile] court shall have exclusive original jurisdiction and shall be the sole court for proceedings in which a juvenile is alleged to be dependent or dependent-neglected from birth to eighteen years of age.

6. The [REDACTED], Juvenile Division, has exclusive original jurisdiction over the matter involving the juvenile. That Court terminated Claimant's parental rights by Order dated March 1, 2024. *See* Exhibit 1. Claimant has no standing to seek reunification nor does this Commission have jurisdiction to hear the matter.

7. In addition, findings were made by the Juvenile Court specifically relating to reunification/rehabilitation attempts. *See* Exhibit 1, pp 4-6. Claimant is barred from re-litigating these issues by the doctrines of collateral estoppel and *res judicata*.

8. The Claims Commission shall not make an award for a claim or action that, as a matter of law, would be dismissed by a court of law for reasons other than sovereign immunity. Ark. Code Ann. § 19-10-204(c).

WHEREFORE, Respondent moves that claim 250621 be dismissed, and for all other just and proper relief to which it may be entitled.

Motion For Summary Judgement

In the matter in the above styled case Beverly Blair v. Makala Blackston the movant petitions the court for mercy in enforcing Social Security Act Title IV-E and Public Law 115-123 Family First Prevention Services Act. Injunctive relief is sought due to facts:

ORDER

Now before the Arkansas State Claims Commission (the “Commission”) is the motion filed by the Arkansas Department of Human Services (the “Respondent”) to dismiss the claim of Beverly Blair (the “Claimant”). Based upon a review of the motion, the claim file, and the law of the State of Arkansas, the Commission hereby finds as follows:

1. Claimant filed her claim asking for “[a]ssistance with reunification” with her child.
2. Respondent filed a motion to dismiss, arguing, *inter alia*, that Claimant’s parental rights were terminated on February 20, 2024, such that Claimant does not have standing to bring this claim. Respondent also argued that the Commission has no jurisdiction over this type of action. Respondent stated that dismissal was proper under Ark. R. Civ. Proc. 12(b)(6). Respondent attached a redacted copy of the [REDACTED] order terminating Claimant’s parental rights.
3. Claimant sent numerous emails to the Commission and/or Respondent, disagreeing that dismissal is proper. In those emails, Claimant referenced violations of her due process rights and concerns with the termination hearing.
4. The Commission finds that dismissal of this claim is proper for lack of jurisdiction. The Commission has no jurisdiction to consider or to take any action with respect to the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] order terminating Claimant’s parental rights. To the extent that Claimant’s

filings could be construed as a claim for violation of due process, the Commission does not have jurisdiction to consider such a claim.

5. Respondent's motion to dismiss is GRANTED, and Claimant's claim is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction.


