Sweat pants, sweat shirts have had them for a while. But emergency condition. Photos - Obviously's. Priceless. I don't know what kind of demand in wages. But I guess I got to put something 1000.00 dollars. This shall cover the legal work, pictures - Obviously's, and hygienics that were missing, mental distress. All this cause of unprofessionalism. I'm not able to give you a definite description of the items. But I can say everything was in immaculate condition.

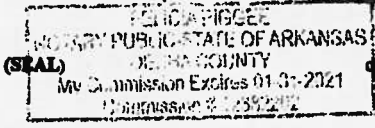



RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

COMES NOW the Respondent, Arkansas Department of Correction, and for its MOTION TO DISMISS, states and responds as follows:


1. Claimant alleges a failure to follow policy, loss of property and mental anguish arising on an incident that occurred on October 28, 2012. Claimant is seeking \$1,000.00.
2. Claimant's complaint fails to state a cause of action under ARCP 12(b)(6) for the reasons listed below and should be dismissed.
3. Claimant is correct that he was in the chow hall when an inmate attacked an officer in the hall. However, Claimant and 12 other inmates came into the hallway and began kicking and stomping staff with their feet. Severe injuries were received by several staff members. Chemical agents were deployed. Claimant and the others retreated and barricaded themselves in Nine Barracks and began breaking out windows. The Emergency Response Team was activated to gain control of the inmates.
4. Property which was not secured in the locker boxes in Nine Barracks where the inmates had barricaded themselves after the inmates had been removed from that location, was gathered and returned to the inmates as ownership was determined. Every effort was made to return property.
5. Claimant's property inventory was completed and his property was returned to him on October 29 and 30, 2012, as it was identified. See Exhibit "A".
6. Claimant received a disciplinary violation for Banding w/another to Commit Assault or Battery, Aggravated Battery - on Staff, Battery upon Staff - Resulting in Injury, Destruct or Intentionally misplace State Property and Any Felony Act Or Misdemeanor. He was found guilty of all the charges.
7. Claimant alleges that he has suffered mental anguish as a result, but there is no evidence that he has received any mental health treatment as a result of losing this property.

8. Claimant alleges that he lost sweat pants and sweat shirt. A review of his commissary records does not indicate that he ever purchased these items. If he did not purchase them, they are the product of trafficking and trading and he is not entitled to compensation. Claimant states that he is indigent and therefore, it is not likely that he purchased these items.
9. Replacement of Claimant's legal work can be obtained from the court or his attorney and he should not be compensated for its replacement.
10. Claimant has failed to state a cause of action for relief and a motion to dismiss is proper when there are no facts upon which relief can be granted. ARCP 12(B)(6).

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above and the evidence submitted, the Claim must be dismissed.
