



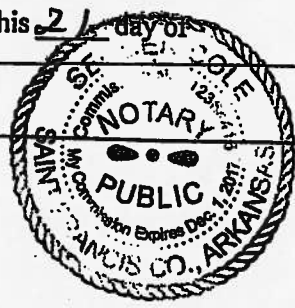

Official Version of Crime: On March 2, 1990, it was reported to the police that a rape had occurred at the Jr. Food Mart on 16th and Cherry. Mary Green, the victim, reported that a black male entered the store and pointed a revolver like handgun at her and forced her to walk into a storage room where he raped her. Ms. Green stated the suspect told her that he only wanted to "fuck" her and did not wish to take money from the register. On March 1, 1990. It was reported to the police department by Narvelle Littleton who lives at 2420 Bell Street in Pine Bluff that she was awoken by a bump at her bedroom door. When Ms. Littleton exited her bedroom and walked in the den area, a black male came from a closet in the den, knocked her to the floor, and pulled her into the dining room area. Once in the dining room, Ms. Littleton was raped by Frank Franklin. It was not charge with this crime this is a lie.

Official Version of Crime:

On March 5, 1990, a burglary and criminal attempt rape was reported to the Altheimer Police Department by Sybil Givens. Ms. Givens reported that a black male came to the door and wanted to use her telephone. Givens reported that five to eight minutes later he came back to her door wanting some water. Givens stated she told the black male to leave or she would call the police. The black male left, but returned a couple of minutes later and forced his way into the home by breaking out the door glass and kicking the door in. The black male, later identified as Frank L. Franklin, then attacked and beat Givens to the floor and told her he was going to teach her a lesson. Franklin then began to remove his pants and while starting to remove them, a police car pulled up in front of the home. Franklin, according to Givens, then fled the home through a back door.

On March 6, 1990, a burglary and rape were reported to the Altheimer Police by Barbara Hilton. Hilton reported that a black male came to her front door on 3-5-90 and wanted to use her telephone. The black male, identified as Frank Franklin, suddenly attacked Hilton, beating her to the floor and raped her. Franklin then carried Hilton into an adjoining bedroom where he bound and gagged her and repeatedly raped and sodomized Hilton.

MOTION TO DISMISS


COMES NOW the Respondent, Arkansas Department of Correction, and for its Motion to Dismiss, states as follows:

1. Claimant has filed an action seeking \$2,000.00 and a transfer for failure to follow policy, mental anguish, and pain and suffering. Claimant has failed to state a claim under ARCP Rule 12(b)(6) and the claim should be dismissed.
2. Claimant alleges that on March 31, 2010, the inmate search details rules and policy was violated and information regarding a rape he was not charged with was made known to the public. He alleges that he has suffered ridicule, sleepless nights, injured his reputation, lost weight because of it.
3. Claimant attaches to his complaint the page of which he claims has the information. This page is not public information, but is contained in the network data information known as eOMIS. The only way in which other inmates know this information is if Claimant, who is not supposed to be in possession of it, shares the information with them.
4. Claimant was convicted of multiple forcible rapes of several different women in the Altheimer and Pine Bluff areas. This information is a public record. However, Claimant is correct that case number 1990-47 is only the rape against Ms. Green at the Food Mart and doesn't contain information regarding Ms. Littleton.
5. The ADC Inmate Search information from the ADC website is attached as Exhibit "A" and references claimant's sexual abuse 1st degree and charge of 1987, rape and burglary conviction in 1990, criminal attempt rape and burglary in 1990, rape conviction in 1990, burglary 1990, and another rape conviction in 1991. Claimant's reputation is evidenced by his record and speaks for itself. See Exhibit "A".
6. Claimant applied for clemency on December 3, 2007, and the information was likely entered at that time by parole for consideration at the clemency hearing.
7. Respondent moves that the commission dismiss this claim. A motion to dismiss is proper when there are no facts upon which relief can be granted. ARCP 12(B)(6).

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays that this claim be dismissed and for all other just and proper relief.

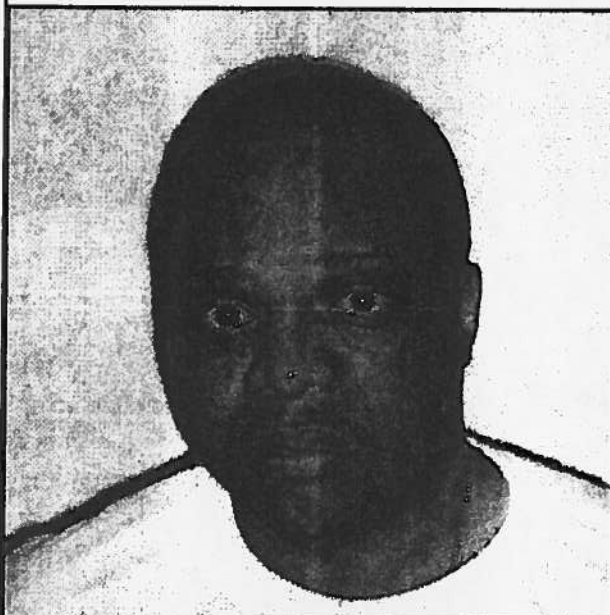

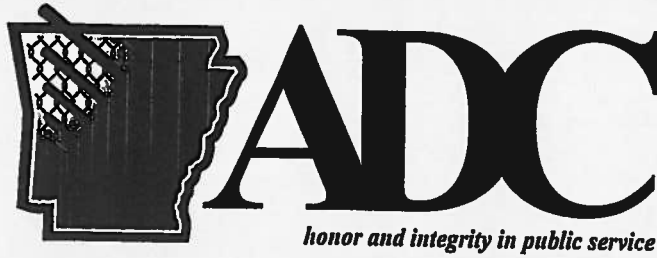

Givens stated she told the black male to leave or she would call the police. The black male left, but returned a couple of minutes later and forced his way into the home by breaking out the door glass and kicking the door in. The black male, later identified as Frank L. Franklin, then attacked and beat Givens to the floor and told her he was going to teach her a lesson. Franklin then carried Hilton into an adjoining bedroom where he bound and gagged her and repeatedly raped and sodomized Hilton.
