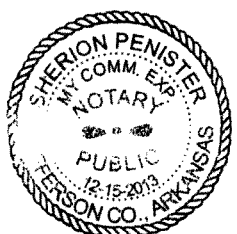

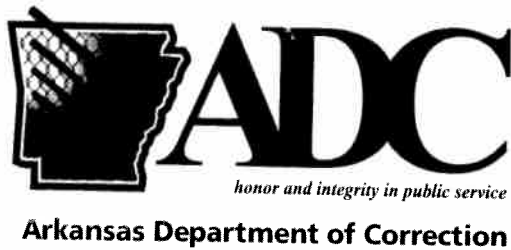

Dear Commissioners:

Please accept this letter as an offer of settlement in the present claim.

As you can see from the attached Disciplinary Violations this particular inmate is disruptive and is frequently subject to time in Isolation; in short, he is a problem inmate. On June 19, 2008, Inmate Early was placed in Isolation for failure to obey staff. His property was collected and upon the return of his property, it appears he was missing a notebook. Whether or not it contained his trial transcript is a matter of speculation upon which we are unable to present definitive evidence.

As you can see from the May 29, 2009 missive from Warden White, the ADC has attempted to resolve this matter. The claimant has stated his mother has a copy of his transcript at her residence in Los Vegas, Nevada. The ADC offered to pay the price of sending the transcript via Federal Express to the Unit, the Unit would copy the transcript in the presence of the claimant and return the transcript to his mother. It seems the Claimant's desire is to have the costs of reproducing the transcript charged to the ADC. As you can see from the letter dated June 3, 2005, from the Office of the Criminal Justice Coordinator, the costs would be around \$650.00.

Also attached for your review is a Request for Interview dated May 29, 2009, outlining the claimant's mother's proposed desires. As you can see from the Request for Interview, the mother now lives in Little Rock, Arkansas.

We are offering to resolve this matter by paying for the transmittal costs of the transcript, copying it in the presence of the claimant and returning the transcript to the claimant's mother. To submit to the demands of the claimant and his mother would result in unjust enrichment and I believe is beyond the pale of reasonable compensation. I fully understand the Commission does not possess the power to render an equitable remedy; however, what we are proposing is reasonable and would place the claimant in possession of his transcript without placing an undue and unnecessary burden on the taxpayers of Arkansas. The ADC would do exactly what the Court would do: photocopy the transcript.

On the date of Monday, May 11, 2009, Lt. J.H. Spears spoke with you, inmate Reginald Early [ADC No. 091994], and advised you that the Arkansas Department of Correction on the unit level [Maximum Security Unit] was putting forth a proposal to acquire a duplicate copy of your trial transcript – which you allege was lost/misplaced by staff during the course of a move.

The unit's proposal entails the unit paying to have the trial transcript – of which you claim to be in possession of your mother in Las Vegas, Nevada – sent via Federal Express to the Maximum Security Unit and then copied in your presence. The trial transcript would then be returned to your mother via Federal Express at the unit's expense.

You refused this proposal – stating that you did not want to do it that way. You want your mother to be paid the sum of six hundred fifty dollars (\$650.00), which is the amount you allege your mother paid to get that copy.

The unit can lower that expense tremendously by going the avenue of the unit's proposal, therefore your proposal is being rejected in regards to the payment for the trial transcript.





Motion For Reconsideration

Comes now the claimant Reginald Early, pro se, and for his motion for reconsideration, pursuant to Arkansas State Claims Commission, rules and regulation, rule 7.1, States:

The Arkansas State Claims Commission unanimously denies and dismisses this claim on 10-16-09, for claimant's failure to prove by a preponderance of the evidence any liability on the part of the respondent. This was error.

A reconsideration of the claimant's claim of loss of property is mandated do to the fact that at the hearing dated 10-16-09, the Arkansas State Claims Commission, Commissioners did not allow the claimant to present the four (4) witnesses testimony that the claimant had requested to testify on the claimant's behalf.

On 9-22-09 the claimant furnished a list of the names of certain witnesses he wished to have present at his hearing to testify of the claimant's behalf, Sgt. Michael Ferriter, Sgt. Sherion Penister, C.O. II Leon Williams and Billy Thornton.

The claimant have the right to call witnesses to testify on his behalf and the claimant followed the rules and resu-

tations of the Arkansas State Claims Commission in requesting the witnesses. It is important for the Claimant to have the option of questioning a witness he calls - or at least of hearing the witnesses and suggesting questions to the hearing Committee - to be sure that all the relevant information is brought out.

Certainly, here the Arkansas State Claims Commission, Commissioners, refusal to hear any of the Four (4) witnesses testimony corroborating the Claimant's claim of loss of Property denied the Claimant a fair and impartial hearing, where the facts are in dispute as to the liability on the part of the respondent.

The Claimant was denied a fair and impartial hearing, because the hearing Committee denied hearing the Claimant's witnesses testimony to prove by direct and cross-examination the liability on the part of the respondent. The Claimant contends the witnesses testimony was very important in establishing liability on the part of the respondent.

The Claimant contends that the Arkansas State Claims Commission, Commissioners refusal to hear or allow the Claimant's witnesses testimony requested was unfair to the Claimant, especially when the Claimant faced a credibility problem trying to prove liability of the Prison guards who lost Claimant's Property.

Here it was the Claimant's responsibility to request that witnesses be called to testify on the Claimant's behalf and

The Claimant did make the request to have witnesses testify on the Claimant's behalf and the Claimant complied with the Arkansas State Claims Commission rules and regulations rule 4.4 in requesting that witnesses be called to testify on Claimant's behalf.

The Claimant contends that staff testimony will always be more credible than Claimant's own testimony and in this case the Claimant's prison staff witnesses testimony corroborating and supporting the Claimant's case, is a case in which the Claimant is most likely to prove liability on the part of the respondent in losing the Claimant's property. To deprive Claimant of the benefit of such witnesses testimony amounts to abandoning any pretense that the hearing is intending to uncover the truth.

Under Arkansas State Claims Commission rules and regulations, rule 7.1 Re-Hearings / Reconsideration, states:

Petitions for Re-Hearings and/or motions for Reconsideration will only be entertained if the set forth new or additional evidence which was not available to the moving party at the time of the scheduled hearing.

The Claimant contends that the new or additional evidence, of the Claimant's requested witnesses testimony was particularly important in the Claimant establishing liability on the part of the respondent. The Claimant contends that his requested witnesses testimony was crucial in establishing

liability on the part of the respondent.

Here the Arkansas State Claims Commission unanimously denies and dismisses this claim for claimant's failure to prove by a preponderance of the evidence any liability on the part of the respondent.

The claimant contends that he was denied a fair and impartial hearing. Further claimant contends he was denied a full opportunity for presentation of evidence, cross-examination of witnesses and argument, ect., see A.S.A. § 19-10-210 (b).

The claimant contends that the Commission should reconsider its decision rendered on 10-16-09, in dismissing the claimant's loss of property claim. The claimant contends his reconsideration request is based upon the fact that the Commission dismissed claimant's claim without hearing claimant's live evidence of witnesses testimony.

The claimant prays that the Commission reconsider its decision to dismiss claimant's loss of property claim and provide claimant with a new hearing that's fair and impartial and that allows claimant to present live evidence, cross-examination of witnesses and argument.

So here the claimant is requesting a re-hearing and requesting the Commission to reconsider its decision to dismiss the claimant's loss of property claim, so that claimant can prove his loss of property claim by the preponderance of the new and additional evidence of live witnesses

testimony and prove the liability on the part of the respon-

re-hearing.

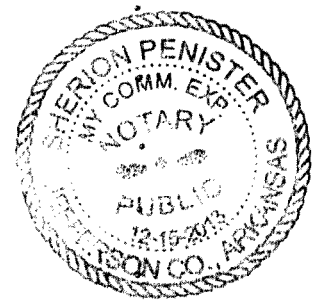
