24 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
25 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
26 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
27 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
28 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
29 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
30 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
31 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
32 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
33 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
34 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
35 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

16  
17 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
19 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of  
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm  
24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.

3 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
 5 TRANSFER. Any funds remaining in the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund

" SECTION 48. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BUDGET REQUEST AND APPROPRIATION BILL TRANSPARENCY. (a) Beginning Fiscal Year 2021 and each Fiscal Year thereafter, the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall submit their budget request as follows: (i) The OPERATIONS appropriation commitment items, expenses, other required and relevant information shall be listed as two separate appropriations requests for STATE FUNDS OPERATIONS - RESEARCH AND EDUCATION and STATE FUNDS OPERATIONS - CLINICAL. (ii) The CASH FUNDS appropriation commitment items, expenses, other required and relevant information shall be listed as two separate appropriations requests for CASH FUNDS - RESEARCH AND EDUCATION and CASH FUNDS - CLINICAL. (b) The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall determine the amount for each of the commitment items, associated revenue receipts and expenses submitted in the budget request as set out in subsection (a) herein. (c) The appropriation bill for the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall reflect the request as recommended by the General Assembly with the separate appropriation sections as authorized in subsection (a). (d) It is the intent of this section that showing the Research/Education and Clinical requests and appropriations will provide the General Assembly with a more transparent understanding of the needs and expenses associated with the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences. It is not the intent that other appropriations already listed separately be combined with the appropriations as set out in subsection (a). (e) The General Assembly shall maintain its prerogative to, at any time, including during budget hearings or through the amendment process, modify or discontinue the requirement of subsection (a) herein. At no time shall the requirements of this section be interpreted to supersede authorized

appropriation commitment item amounts adopted by the General Assembly during budget hearings or through the amendment process.”

It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.

(6) Use Arkansas Health Insurance Marketplace funds to purchase a gift with the intent to give the gift to an applicant or potential enrollee;

(7) Solicit any consumer for application or enrollment assistance by going door-to-door or through other means of direct contact, including calling a consumer to provide application or enrollment assistance without the consumer initiating the contact, unless the licensee has a pre-

existing relationship with the consumer and complies with other applicable state and federal laws; or

(8) Initiate a telephone call to a consumer using an automatic telephone dialing system or an artificial or prerecorded voice technology, except in cases in which the licensee has a relationship with the consumer and complies with other applicable state and federal laws."
