



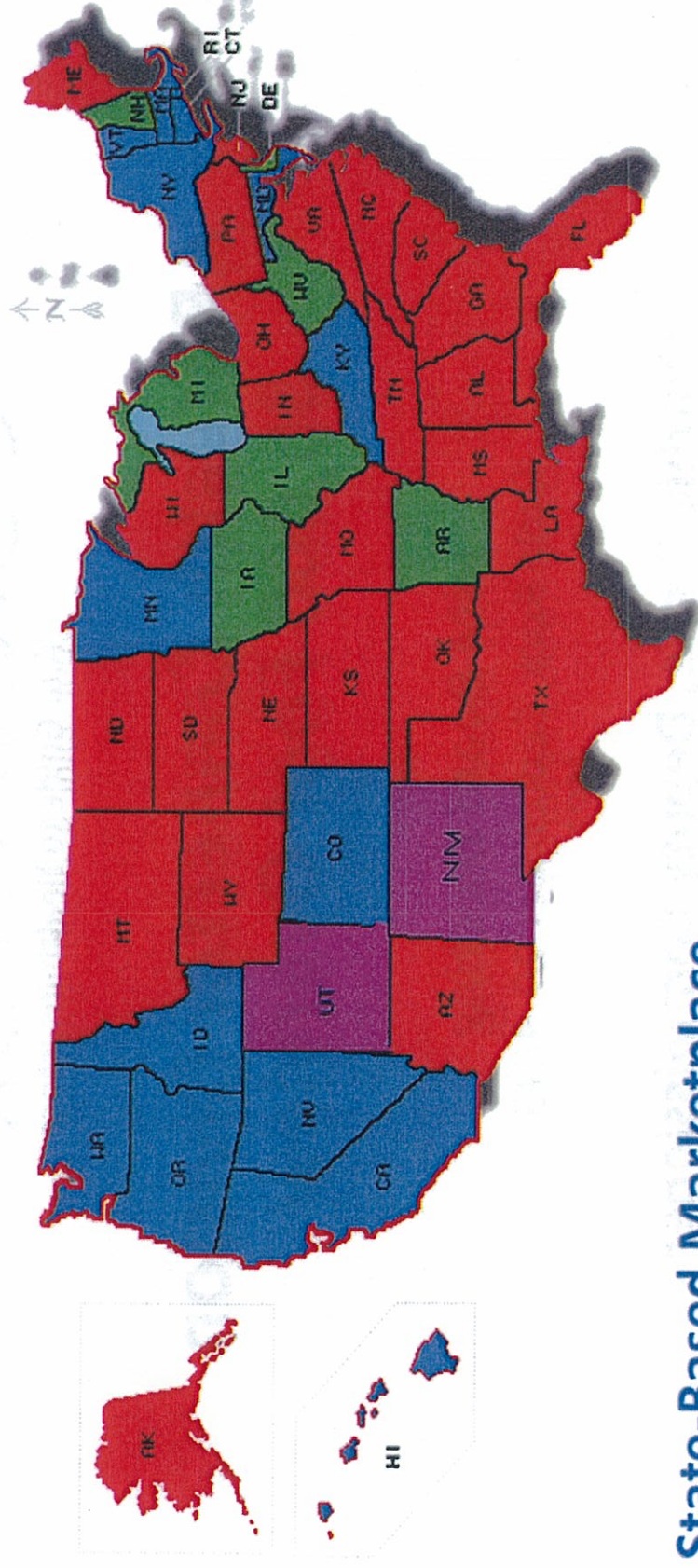

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Overview of SBM Blueprint Application

States seeking to operate a State-based Marketplace must complete a Marketplace Blueprint Application and submit it to HHS for approval.

The application is structured around **Marketplace activities**, which states must complete (or provide date of expected completion) in order to be approved as an SBM consistent with the Affordable Care Act (ACA) and associated regulations.

MARKETPLACE ACTIVITIES:

1. Legal Authority and Governance
2. Consumer and Stakeholder Engagement and Support
3. Eligibility and Enrollment
4. Plan Management
5. Risk Adjustment
6. SHOP
7. Organization and Human Resources
8. Finance and Accounting
9. Technology
10. Privacy and Security
11. Oversight and Monitoring
12. Contingency Planning
13. Re-Use (IT and non-IT reuse materials)

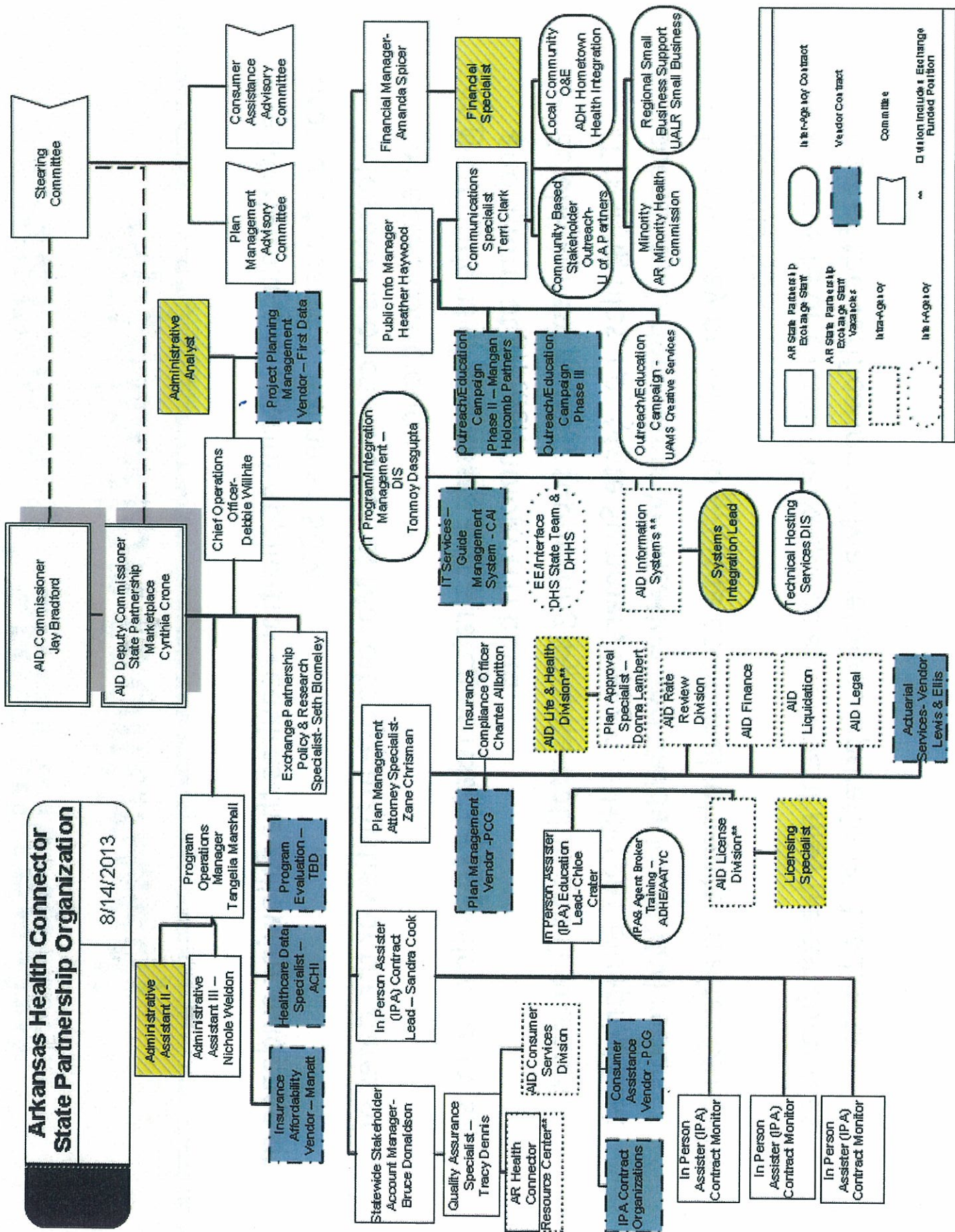
Overview of SBM Blueprint

Application (continued)

- The Marketplace Blueprint Application requires the following evidence of progress towards building an SBM:
 - Attestations of completion of Marketplace activities or the dates of expected completion
 - Descriptions of processes and strategies relating to policy, business, and information technology (IT) build
 - Establishment Review supporting documentation and IT artifacts
 - IT testing files, i.e., State Summary Report, HHS-CMS Blueprint test scenarios, Independent Verification and Validation (IV&V) report
 - A state may be asked to provide additional information after Blueprint submission:
 - An on-site or virtual Marketplace assessment may be conducted as part of the verification of Marketplace Operational Readiness
