3 REQUESTING THAT THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY STUDY THE
4 NECESSITY AND THE POSSIBLE REDUCTION OR ELIMINATION OF FEES
5 ASSOCIATED WITH THE APPLICATION FOR AND THE ISSUANCE OF A LICENSE
6 TO CARRY A CONCEALED HANDGUN.

8 WHEREAS, under § 5-73-309(9), a person who applies for a license to
9 carry a concealed handgun must desire a legal means to carry a concealed
10 handgun to defend himself or herself; and

11
12 WHEREAS, a person should not be required to pay a fee in order to
13 attempt to protect himself or herself from harm; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the assessment of fees associated with the application for and
16 the issuance of a license to carry a concealed handgun is an undue burden
17 that should be reduced or altogether eliminated; and

19 WHEREAS, the reduction or elimination of fees associated with the
20 application for and the issuance of a license to carry a concealed handgun
21 should be studied by the Senate Committee on Judiciary,

23 NOW THEREFORE,

24 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY OF THE NINETY-FIRST
25 GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

26 THAT the Senate Committee on Judiciary study the necessity of fees
27 associated with the application for and issuance of a license to carry a
28 concealed handgun and the possible reduction or elimination of fees
29 associated with the application for and the issuance of a license to carry a
30 concealed handgun.
