3 REQUESTING THE HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE  
4 AND LABOR AND THE SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH,  
5 WELFARE AND LABOR STUDY THE EFFECTS OF REMOVING THE COLLABORATIVE  
6 AGREEMENT REQUIREMENT FOR ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSES.  
7

8 WHEREAS, under current Arkansas law, an advanced practice nurse may be  
9 granted a certificate of prescriptive authority only if the nurse has a  
10 collaborative practice agreement with an Arkansas physician who has a  
11 practice comparable in scope, specialty, or expertise to that of the advanced  
12 practice nurse; and  
13

14 WHEREAS, the requirement for collaborative agreements may limit the  
15 availability of advanced practice nurses in the state, particularly in  
16 medically underserved areas; and  
17

18 WHEREAS, 14 states (Alaska, Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Iowa, Maine,  
19 Montana, New Hampshire, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, Washington, Wyoming, and  
20 Vermont) and the District of Columbia authorize advanced practice nurses to  
21 practice without a collaborative agreement; and

23 WHEREAS, Arkansas has consistently ranked among the least healthy  
24 states in the nation; and  
25

26 WHEREAS, many Arkansans who cannot find or afford primary care from a  
27 physician must seek their primary health care through hospital emergency  
28 rooms, a method which is both more expensive and less efficient than office  
29 visits; and  
30

31 WHEREAS, expanded opportunities for primary health care by advanced  
32 practice nurses could reduce the costs of health care and increase  
33 preventative care opportunities while maintaining the safety and efficacy of  
34 health care in this state,

36 NOW THEREFORE,

1 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND  
2 LABOR OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

4 THAT the House Interim Committee On Public Health, Welfare And Labor  
5 and the Senate Interim Committee On Public Health, Welfare And Labor study  
6 the effects of removing the collaborative agreement requirement for advanced  
7 practice nurses.
