SENATE BILL 259

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE HOSPITAL BOARD TO DONATE ONE ACRE OF LAND BELONGING TO THE BENTON SERVICES CENTER OF THE MENTAL HEALTH DIVISION OF THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO THE MT. HARMONY CEMETERY FOR CEMETERY BURIAL USE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The State Hospital Board is hereby authorized to donate by conveyance for nominal consideration one (1) acre of land belonging to the Benton Services Center of the Division of Mental Health Services of the Arkansas Department of Human Services and situated adjacent to the Mt. Harmony Cemetery to the Mt. Harmony Cemetery for cemetery burial use.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the community cemetery known as the Mt. Harmony Cemetery, which adjoins land belonging to the Benton Services Center of the Division of Mental Health Services of the Arkansas Department of Human Services, has provided registered burial access for the State of Arkansas and that the needs of the local community now require the conveyance of an additional acre of land to the Mt. Harmony Cemetery by the State Hospital Board for community cemetery burial purposes. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
