SENATE BILL 345

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS STATUTE 19-1721 TO GRANT MUNICIPAL
LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND MUNICIPAL FIREFIGHTERS THE
OPTION OF RECEIVING HOLIDAY PAY IN ONE LUMP SUM EACH YEAR;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 252 of 1985, the same being Arkansas
Statute 19-1721, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. All law enforcement officers (regardless of their titles,
such as city marshal) and firefighters employed by cities of the first or
second class or incorporated towns shall be compensated for all legal holidays
established by the governing body of the municipality. Such compensation
shall be based on the law enforcement officer's or firefighter's daily rate
of pay, and in addition to the regular pay schedule. Such compensation may
be included within the officer's or firefighter's base pay. Such compensation
shall be prorated and paid during the regular payroll periods or paid in one
lump sum annually on a date in December designated by the municipality."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
hereby repealed.
