SENATE BILL 666

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT WHEN THE STATE PLANT BOARD PLACES ANY FEEDS UNDER SEIZURE AS AUTHORIZED IN SECTION 7 OF ACT 108 OF 1951, AND ALL SUCH FEED IS SOLD OR USED, A PENALTY SHALL BE ASSESSED AGAINST THE MANUFACTURER, IMPORTER, JOBBER, AGENT OR DEALER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. When the State Plant Board places any concentrated commercial feeding stuff under seizure as authorized in Section 7 of Act 108 of 1951 and all such feed has been sold or used, the Board shall assess a penalty against the manufacturer, importer, jobber, agent or dealer selling or offering such feed for sale or distribution as follows: \$25.00 for lots of one bag to five tons, and for lots over five tons an additional \$10.00 per ton or fraction

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
