SENATE BILL 78

"AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (c) OF SECTION 1 OF ACT 106 OF 1969 AS AMENDED, [ARK. STATS. 75-1045 (c)] TO PROVIDE THAT WHEN ANY PERSON SUBMITS TO A BLOOD, BREATH OR URINE TEST TO DETERMINE BLOOD ALCOHOL CONTENT FOR PURPOSES OF THE ARKANSAS OMNIBUS DWI ACT, THE PERSON, AGENCY OR INSTITUTION ADMINISTERING THE TEST SHALL REPORT THE FINDINGS OF SUCH TEST TO THE PERSON TESTED BY CERTIFIED MAIL WITHIN FIVE DAYS AFTER THE TEST IS ADMINISTERED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of Section 1 of Act 106 of 1969, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statutes 75-1045(c), is hereby amended by adding a new paragraph at the end thereof to read as follows:

"(5) When any blood, breath or urine test is administered pursuant to this Act to determine the level of alcohol in the blood of any person, whether at the direction of a law enforcement officer or upon request of the person tested, the person, agency or institution administering the test shall, within five (5) days after the date on which the tests are administered, report the results of the tests to the person tested by sending a copy of the results to the person tested by certified mail addressed to his or her last known address."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
