REQUESTING THE ARKANSAS HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION
DEPARTMENT TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF WIDENING HIGHWAY 64
FROM MARION TO BALD KNOB INTO A MULTI-LANE HIGHWAY, AND TO
STUDY VARIOUS METHODS OF FINANCING THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the increase in the number of vehicles traveling Highway 64
from Marion to Bald Knob has increased drastically in recent years; and

WHEREAS, widening that portion of Highway 64 should be accomplished as
soon as possible in order to reduce the risk of harm to persons traversing
the highway,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department is hereby
requested to study the feasibility of widening Highway 64 from Marion to
Bald Knob into a multi-lane highway, and to study methods of financing the
project, including but not limited to utilizing the toll road concept.
