HOUSE RESOLUTION

TO AMEND THE HOUSE RULES TO EXPAND THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE
HOUSE RULES COMMITTEE FROM FOURTEEN MEMBERS TO TWENTY MEMBERS
AND TO PRESCRIBE THE METHOD OF SELECTION AND TERMS OF THE SIX
ADDITIONAL MEMBERS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Seventy-Seventh
General Assembly are hereby amended as follows:

"The House Rules Committee shall consist of twenty (20) members. In
addition to the fourteen (14) members of the Committee provided for in House
Rule 51 and selected as provided in House Rule 52, there shall be six (6)
additional members to be appointed by the Speaker from the House at large for
terms of two (2) years. Persons appointed to the six (6) additional positions
shall not be eligible to serve two (2) successive terms on the committee in
any of the six (6) additional positions."
