SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
16 Office of Emergency Services for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum
17 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions
18 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201
19 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,
20 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set
21 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
22 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
25 successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Office of Emergency Services for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: One (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of Emergency Services, to be payable from the State General Services Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of Emergency Services - State Operations for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

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28 SECTION 9. REGULAR SALARIES - FIRE PROTECTION BOARD. There is hereby

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31 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
 32 this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
 33 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
 34 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
 35 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and

1 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
2 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
3 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
4 with in disbursement of said funds.

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6 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
8 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
10 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
13 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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15 SECTION 13. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
16 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
17 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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19 SECTION 14. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
20 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
21 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given
22 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
23 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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25 SECTION 15. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
26 this Act are hereby repealed.

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28 SECTION 16. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Office of Emergency Services shall not,
29 during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per employee
30 than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health Insurance
31 Program.

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33 SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
34 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
35 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year

1 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
2 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
3 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
4 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
5 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
6 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
7 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
8 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.

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
