15 RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING ARKANSAS HOSPITALS AND THE
16 HOSPITAL ASSOCIATION FOR RAISING FUNDS TO LAUNCH A
17 PHYSICAL THERAPY PROGRAM AT ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY.

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19 WHEREAS, there presently exists a shortage in the number of physical
20 therapists practicing within the State of Arkansas; and

21 WHEREAS, the hospitals of Arkansas and the Arkansas Hospital Association
22 have raised three hundred and fifty thousand dollars for start-up funds to
23 launch a physical therapy program at Arkansas State University; and

24 WHEREAS, the ASU physical therapy program now becomes the state's second
25 physical therapy program joining one that has been in operation at the
26 University of Central Arkansas for many years; and

27 WHEREAS, these two programs will now constitute a substantial effort to
28 solve the state's critical shortage of physical therapists,

29 NOW THEREFORE,

30 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE
31 SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF
32 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

33 That the hospitals of Arkansas and the Arkansas Hospital Association are
34 hereby recognized and commended for raising funds to launch a physical therapy
35 program at Arkansas State University to help alleviate the shortage of

1 physical therapists in Arkansas.
