# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1917

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-20-104(b) TO PROVIDE  
9 THAT PERSONS WHO ARE TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER  
10 SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR WHILE  
11 OPERATING OR RIDING A MOTORCYCLE OR MOTOR-DRIVEN CYCLE;  
12 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "AMEND ARK. CODE 27-20-104(b) TO PROVIDE  
16 THAT PERSONS 21 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER  
17 SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROTECTIVE  
18 HEADGEAR WHILE OPERATING OR RIDING A  
19 MOTORCYCLE OR MOTOR-DRIVEN CYCLE."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22  
23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-20-104(b) is hereby amended to read as  
24 follows:

25 "(b) All passengers and operators of motorcycles, mopeds, minibikes,  
26 motorscooters and motor-driven cycles used upon the public streets and  
27 highways of this state shall be equipped with the following equipment under  
28 standards set forth by the Office of Motor Vehicle of the State of Arkansas:

29 (1) Protective headgear unless the person is twenty-one (21) years of  
30 age or older; and

31 (2) Protective glasses, goggles, or transparent face shields."

32  
33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
34 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
35 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
