## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
11 PARKS AND TOURISM - HISTORY COMMISSION FOR THE  
12 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2001; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - HISTORY COMMISSION. There is hereby  
25 established for the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission for  
26 the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees  
27 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
28 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or  
29 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
30 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
31 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
32 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
33 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
34 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - HISTORY COMMISSION. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - HISTORY COMMISSION - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission, to be payable from the Parks and Tourism Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

13 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - HISTORY COMMISSION - CASH. There is hereby  
 14 appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission, to  
 15 be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the  
 16 Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission, for operating expenses  
 17 of the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission for the biennial  
 18 period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

30 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 31 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 33 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

3  
4 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
6 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
10 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
11 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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13 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
14 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
15 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

16  
17 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application  
18 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
19 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given  
20 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
21 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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23 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
24 this act are hereby repealed.

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26 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
27 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
28 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
29 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to  
30 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are  
31 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the  
32 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work  
33 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
34 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
35 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
36 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after

1 July 1, 1999.
