8 **SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

9 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR  
10 SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY  
11 UNTIL 12:00 NOON, MAY 14, 2001; TO PROVIDE FOR  
12 RECESS OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT  
13 THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON APRIL 13, 2001; TO  
14 AUTHORIZE THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE  
15 AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,  
16 BY JOINT PROCLAMATION, TO RECONVENE THE GENERAL  
17 ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE 12:00 NOON, MAY 14,  
18 2001 FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING VETOES,  
19 CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, COMPLETING ITS  
20 WORK ON PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS,  
21 CONSIDERING CERTAIN LEGISLATION CONCERNING  
22 RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF  
23 STATE LEGISLATURES, AND CONSIDERING THE NEED FOR  
24 FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR SESSION, OR TO  
25 ADJOURN THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY  
26 TIME BEFORE THAT DATE IF THEY DETERMINE THAT  
27 THERE IS NO NEED TO RECONVENE; TO PROVIDE THAT IF  
28 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS NOT RECONVENED OR  
29 ADJOURNED BEFORE 12:00 NOON, MAY 14, 2001, THE  
30 REGULAR SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL  
31 ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED SINE DIE ON THAT DATE.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

(1) That the Regular Session of the Eighty-third General Assembly of the State of Arkansas is extended until 12:00 Noon, May 14, 2001;

(2) That the Regular Session of the Eighty-third General Assembly of the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess at the close of business on April 13, 2001, or at such earlier time as may be agreed upon by the Senate and the House of Representatives; and

(3) That the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives may, by joint proclamation:

(A) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00 Noon, May 14, 2001, for the purpose of:

- (i) Considering vetoes;
- (ii) Correcting errors and oversights;
- (iii) Completing its work on proposed constitutional amendments, including but not limited to any constitutional amendment or amendments dealing with public school finance which may be needed or required as a result of a court decision in the pending litigation involving the Lakeview School District;
- (iv) Considering House Bill 2373, Senate Bill 810, Senate Bill 812, Senate Concurrent Resolution 14, Senate Concurrent Resolution 15, Senate Concurrent Resolution 16, and Senate Concurrent Resolution 17 relating to implementation of recommendations of the National Conference of State Legislatures concerning the Arkansas General Assembly; and
- (v) Considering the need for further extension of the Regular Session of the Eighty-third General Assembly; or

(B) Adjourn the Regular Session of the Eighty-third General Assembly at any time before that date if they determine it is not necessary to reconvene.

(4) That if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before 12:00 Noon, May 14, 2001, the Regular Session of the Eighty-third General

1 Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date.
