EDUCATION FROM USING STUDENTS' OR EMPLOYEES'
SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS ON IDENTIFICATION CARDS;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT INSTITUTIONS OF
HIGHER EDUCATION FROM USING STUDENTS' OR
EMPLOYEES' SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS ON
IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. No public or private institution of higher education shall:
(1) Print a student's or employee's social security number, or any
part of the number, on the student's or employee's identification card.
(2) Make a student's or employee's social security number available by
reading the magnetic strip or other encoded information on the student's or
employee's identification card.
