AN ACT TO PROHIBIT SCHOOLS FROM GIVING STATE
MANDATED TESTS WITHIN THREE (3) DAYS FOLLOWING
THE SPRING DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME CHANGE; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT SCHOOLS FROM GIVING
STATE MANDATED TESTS WITHIN THREE (3)
DAYS FOLLOWING THE SPRING DAYLIGHT
SAVINGS TIME CHANGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Beginning with the 2003-2004 school year, no state mandated
test shall be given by any public school district or required by the
Department of Education to be given within three (3) days following the
spring daylight savings time change.
