SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

9 PROPOSING A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO BE KNOWN

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
22 STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL
23 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

25 That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
26 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
27 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Senators and
28 Representatives, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the
29 election, adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the
30 Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

32 SECTION 1. (a) All persons have the right to hunt, fish, and harvest
33 game in this state in accordance with law and regulations.

34 (b) This amendment shall be known as the "Sportsperson's Bill of
35 Rights."



SECTION 2. This amendment shall become effective January 1, 2005.
