16 WHEREAS, Reverend P. L. Perkins was born in Duncan, Mississippi, on
17 February 6, 1917, to the late Ellis Perkins and the late Lucille Perkins; and

19 WHEREAS, Reverend Perkins moved to Helena in the mid-forties, and
20 began his musical career singing with the popular group, The Glory Bound; and

22 WHEREAS, Reverend Perkins was manager, arranger, and singer with the
23 greatest popular music group of its time, The Five Blind Boys of Mississippi;

26 WHEREAS, Reverend Perkins musical career spanned many decades from the
27 fifties with hit songs on the top ten Rhythm and Blues Hit List to his
28 induction into the Music Gospel Hall of Fame in October 2000,
