23 WHEREAS, Act 1398 of 2001, sponsored by former State Senator John Riggs  
24 of Little Rock, created the Arkansas Blue Ribbon Commission on Public  
25 Education and charged it to define the components of the constitutional  
26 mandate for "a general, suitable and efficient system of free public  
27 schools", define an equitable and adequate system of free public education,  
28 assess current efforts to improve the state's system of public education,  
29 actively involve the private sector as full and valued partners in the  
30 improvement process, and recommend legislation for the 2003 Regular Session  
31 of the General Assembly; and

34 the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the  
35 Senate, the Chair of the House Interim Committee on Education, and the Chair
