19 WHEREAS, Charles E. Knox, the Assistant Executive Director of the
20 Arkansas Association of Educational Administrators (AAEA), is recognized for
21 his extensive background and experience in public education in Arkansas, his
22 excellent reputation as a leader in public school education, and his
23 abilities and skills as an articulate spokesman for public education in
24 Arkansas and his unique ability to work with the Arkansas General Assembly;

27 WHEREAS, Charles E. Knox has had an impressive career through
28 monumental changes in Arkansas public education beginning as a junior high
29 school principal in Cabot, then a high school principal in Batesville, and
30 eventually serving as superintendent for the Ozark School District and the
31 Lonoke School District; and

33 WHEREAS, during his career in public education Mr. Charles Knox has
34 received numerous honors and awards, including being elected as President of
35 the Arkansas Association of Secondary School Principals, President of the
36 Arkansas Association of Educational Administrators (1980-81) which is the



1 umbrella association of nine administrator organizations, and President of
2 the Arkansas Association of School Administrators (1990-91), being named as
3 Arkansas' Superintendent of the Year in 1990-91, and serving as Assistant
4 Executive Director of Arkansas Association of Educational Administrators
5 since 1994; and

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7 WHEREAS, Charles Knox has been a pillar of his community by serving in
8 other leadership and civic roles as a member of the local chambers of
9 commerce in Lonoke and in Ozark and as Chairman of the City of Cabot's Parks
10 and Recreation Committee, and it was through his vision and creativity he was
11 instrumental in the construction of the AAEA headquarters that are presently
12 used by the organization,
