21 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
22 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that ???; that ???; and that this
23 act is immediately necessary because ???. Therefore, an emergency is declared
24 to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
25 public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

26 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

27 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
28 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
29 bill; or

30 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
31 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
