22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training for the 2012-
26 2013 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, for operating expenses of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training - Special Training for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the following:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - 911 TRAINING & EDUCATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training - 911 Training & Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the following:

2 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
4 FORWARD. Any unexpended balances of funds authorized for Capital Outlay in
5 Section 2 of this Act on June 30, ~~2010~~ 2013, shall be carried forward and
6 made available for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending June 30,
7 ~~2011~~ 2014.

8 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may
9 be carried forward under the following conditions:

10 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2010~~ 2013, the Agency shall by written statement set
11 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
12 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

13 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
14 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from
15 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the
16 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
17 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which
18 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
19 and the amount of funding carried forward from the first fiscal year to the
20 second fiscal year, the program name or line item, the funding source and a
21 copy of the written request set forth in (1) above;

22 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
23 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
24 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
25 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
26 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
27 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
28 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
29 Committee; and

30 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
31 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
32 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.
33

34 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7
8 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

17 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
19 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
