AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTIONS
OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS NORTHEASTERN COLLEGE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Northeastern College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas Northeastern College the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 546 of 2011, for construction of a Nursing and Allied Health building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,150,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$240,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$210,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 546 of 2011, to prevent the loss of funding for personal services, operating expenses and economic development grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education



Consortium initiatives, in a sum not to exceed.....\$415,681.

(E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) Section 1 of Act 546 of 2011, for personal services, operating expenses and grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium University Center initiatives, in a sum not to exceed.....\$172,137.

(F) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 391 of 2011, for construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, maintenance, personal services and operating expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$300,000.

SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - BLACK RIVER TECHNICAL COLLEGE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Black River Technical College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Black River Technical College the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 546 of 2011, for construction of a Health Sciences addition, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 546 of 2011, for construction of an Academic Complex at the Paragould site, in a sum not to exceed.....\$200,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$270,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 2 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$260,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 710 of 2011, for construction, renovation, maintenance, major maintenance, and purchase of equipment for capital improvements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,000,000.

SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - COLLEGE OF THE OUACHITAS. There is hereby appropriated, to the College of The Ouachitas, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the College of The Ouachitas the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 9 of Act 546 of 2011, for technology infrastructure improvements and upgrades, including but not limited to, routers, switches, firewalls, and cabling, in a sum not to exceed.....\$230,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 9 of Act 546 of 2011, for construction of an Applied Science and Business Instructional building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$820,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 9 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$160,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 9 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$140,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 388 of 2011, for course materials, operations and programmatic costs for the Nursing Program, in a sum not to exceed.....\$100,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) Section 11 of Act 693 of 2011, for construction/renovation/maintenance/critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed.....\$100,000.

SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - COSSATOT COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 546 of 2011, for instructional classroom technology, in a sum not to exceed.....\$38,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 3 of Act 546 of 2011, for renovation of the Cosmetology Laboratory and Classroom, in a sum not to exceed.....\$119,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 3 of Act 546 of 2011, for renovations of classrooms and a

computer laboratory, in a sum not to exceed.....\$142,800.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 3 of Act 546 of 2011, for construction of classrooms and a laboratory at the Howard county campus, in a sum not to exceed\$750,200.

(E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) Section 3 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$220,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) Section 3 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$140,000.

(G) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 267 of 2011, for construction, land acquisition, renovation, maintenance, critical maintenance, technology upgrades, furnishing, equipment and library resources, in a sum not to exceed\$1,000,000.

(H) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 4 of Act 693 of 2011, for construction/renovation/maintenance/critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed.....\$100,000.

(I) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 4 of Act 693 of 2011, for construction, equipment, maintenance and operation expense, in a sum not to exceed.....\$150,000.

(J) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 4 of Act 693 of 2011, for construction, renovation, purchase of equipment, improvements and major maintenance for a Classroom Facility for Mathematics, Science and Astronomy, in a sum not to exceed\$98,000.

SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - EAST ARKANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE. There is hereby appropriated, to the East Arkansas Community College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the East Arkansas Community College the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 4 of Act 546 of 2011, for renovation of the Allied Health Facility, in a sum not to exceed.....\$890,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 4 of Act 546 of 2011, for renovation of Classroom Building 2, in a sum not to exceed.....\$210,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 4 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$130,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 4 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$160,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) Section 4 of Act 546 of 2011, to prevent the loss of funding for personal services, operating expenses and economic development grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium initiatives, in a sum not to exceed.....\$633,779.

(F) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) Section 4 of Act 546 of 2011, for personal services, operating expenses and grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium University Center initiatives, in a sum not to exceed.....\$172,137.

(G) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) Section 4 of Act 546 of 2011, for regional economic development projects and grants, in a sum not to exceed.....\$200,000.

(H) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 390 of 2011, for construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, maintenance, personal services and operating expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$200,000.

(I) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 464 of 2011, for personal services and operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$100,000.

SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - MID-SOUTH COMMUNITY COLLEGE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Mid-South Community College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Mid-South Community College the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided

in Item (A) Section 5 of Act 546 of 2011, for renovation of science laboratories, in a sum not to exceed.....\$157,500.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 5 of Act 546 of 2011, for purchase of generators to support technical infrastructure, in a sum not to exceed.....\$350,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 5 of Act 546 of 2011, for construction of a Wellness Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$642,500.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 5 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$280,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) Section 5 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$180,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) Section 5 of Act 546 of 2011, to prevent the loss of funding for personal services, operating expenses and economic development grants to support the continuation of Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium initiatives, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,529,789.

(G) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) Section 5 of Act 546 of 2011, for personal services, operating expenses and grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium University Center initiatives, in a sum not to exceed.....\$353,925.

(H) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 456 of 2011, for personal services and operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$100,000.

(I) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 6 of Act 693 of 2011, to prevent the loss of funding for personal services, operating expenses and economic development grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium initiatives, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,153,807.

(J) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) Section 6 of Act 693 of 2011, for personal services, operating expenses, and grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta

Training and Education Consortium University Center initiatives, in a sum not to exceed.....\$38,454.

(K) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) Section 6 of Act 693 of 2011, for personal services, operating expenses, equipment and grants to the University Partners, in a sum not to exceed.....\$351,910.

SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - NATIONAL PARK COMMUNITY COLLEGE. There is hereby appropriated, to the National Park Community College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the National Park Community College the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 6 of Act 546 of 2011, for infrastructure improvements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$949,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 6 of Act 546 of 2011, for classroom technology upgrades, in a sum not to exceed.....\$401,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 6 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$350,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 6 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$360,000.

SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - NORTH ARKANSAS COLLEGE - CASH FUNDS - AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT. There is hereby appropriated, to the North Arkansas College, to be payable from the cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for the North Arkansas College the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 8 of Act 693 of 2011 and Act 1106 of 2011, for the Campus Center Tower - HVAC Energy Efficiency Upgrades, in a sum not to exceed\$480,238.

SECTION 9. REAPPROPRIATION - NORTH ARKANSAS COLLEGE - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the North Arkansas College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund

accounts, for the North Arkansas College the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 7 of Act 546 of 2011, for construction of a Campus Center and a STEM Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,200,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 7 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$340,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 7 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$270,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 406 of 2011, for land acquisition, improvements, personal services, construction, equipping, operations and maintenance for the Berryville Campus, in a sum not to exceed.....\$250,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 527 of 2011, for construction and/or renovation, furnishing, and equipping of general purpose academic classrooms and faculty offices, and laboratories and classrooms for science, technology, engineering, and mathematics, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 9 of Act 693 of 2011, for construction, renovation, equipment, acquisition, furnishing, personal services, maintenance and operations expenses of the Searcy county campuses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$25,000.

(G) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) Section 9 of Act 693 of 2011, for costs associated with land acquisition, improvements, construction, equipping, operations and maintenance for the Berryville Campus, in a sum not to exceed.....\$66,502.

(H) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) Section 9 of Act 693 of 2011, for personal services, operations and equipment acquisition expenses of the Northark Agriculture and Rodeo Program, in a sum not to exceed.....\$20,410.

(I) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (H) Section 9 of Act 693 of 2011, for the construction, renovation, furnishing and equipping of the Campus Center on the North Arkansas College South Campus, in a sum not to exceed.....\$70,243.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Northwest Arkansas Community College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Northwest Arkansas Community College the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 8 of Act 546 of 2011, for renovation of the National Child Protection Training Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$250,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 8 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,760,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 8 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$770,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 438 of 2011, for operations, construction, renovation, improvements, purchase and maintenance of equipment, maintenance and major maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$250,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) Section 10 of Act 693 of 2011, for construction/renovation/maintenance/critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed.....\$24,053.

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 30 of Act 692 of 2011 and Section 34 of Act 692 of 2011, for the acquisition, management, stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or objects - Mountain View Amphitheater Construction, in a sum not to exceed.....\$165,000.

SECTION 12. REAPPROPRIATION - OZARKA COLLEGE - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Ozarka College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Ozarka College the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 10 of Act 546 of 2011, for construction and renovation of an Allied Health Building , in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 10 of Act 546 of 2011, for construction of a Technology Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$50,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 10 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$150,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 10 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$140,000.

(H) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (J) Section 12 of Act 693 of 2011, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed\$18,037.

(I) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (M) Section 12 of Act 693 of 2011, for operations, construction, renovations, and other capital improvement related costs for Ozarka College, in a sum not to exceed.....\$51,384.

SECTION 13. REAPPROPRIATION - PHILLIPS COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Phillips Community College of the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Phillips Community College of the University of Arkansas the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 11 of Act 546 of 2011, for repairs to the drainage system at the DeWitt campus, in a sum not to exceed.....\$450,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 11 of Act 546 of 2011, for window repairs at the Stuttgart campus, in a sum not to exceed.....\$65,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 11 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement of the Fine Arts Building chiller, in a sum not to exceed.....\$270,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 11 of Act 546 of 2011, for repairs to a chiller at the Stuttgart campus, in a sum not to exceed.....\$115,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) Section 11 of Act 546 of 2011, for roof replacements for six (6) buildings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$250,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) Section 11 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$860,000.

(K) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 14 of Act 693 of 2011, to prevent the loss of funding for personal services, operating expenses and economic development grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium initiatives, in a sum not to exceed.....\$351,801.

(B) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 12 of Act 546 of 2011, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$350,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2012, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 12 of Act 546 of 2011, for replacement and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,060,000.

SECTION 22. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
