# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1101

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE EMPLOYMENT OF AN EMPLOYEE THAT ENTERED INTO A STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM DEFERRED RETIREMENT OPTION PLAN AND TERMINATED EMPLOYMENT; TO REQUIRE AN EMPLOYEE RETURNING TO EMPLOYMENT AND AN EMPLOYER THAT PARTICIPATES IN A STATE-SUPPORTED RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO MAKE CONTRIBUTIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE EMPLOYMENT OF A TERMINATED EMPLOYEE; TO REQUIRE AN EMPLOYEE RETURNING TO EMPLOYMENT AND AN EMPLOYER THAT PARTICIPATES IN A STATE-SUPPORTED RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO MAKE CONTRIBUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this bill is to amend the statutes concerning the employment of an employee that entered into a state retirement system deferred retirement option plan and terminated employment; and to require an employee returning to employment and an employer that participates in a state-supported retirement system to make contributions.
