For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT LAW; TO REGULATE THE PROCUREMENT OF PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRUCKS; TO ALLOW *CERTAIN STATE ENTITIES* TO PURCHASE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRUCKS FROM A SOURCE OUTSIDE OF A STATE CONTRACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT LAW; TO REGULATE THE PROCUREMENT OF PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRUCKS; AND TO ALLOW CERTAIN STATE ENTITIES TO PURCHASE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRUCKS FROM A SOURCE OUTSIDE OF A STATE CONTRACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-11-222(a), concerning the State Procurement Director's exclusive jurisdiction over procurement, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The State Procurement Director shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the procurement of:

- (1) ~~Items~~ Printing, stationery, and supplies subject to Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 54;
- (2) Wholesale gasoline, oil, and related products;
- (3) Tires;
- (4) ~~Passenger motor vehicles and trucks, except highway construction and highway maintenance equipment or any specialized type of~~



~~equipment used in highway construction, except as otherwise provided in this subchapter;~~

- ~~(5)~~ Paper products;
- ~~(6)~~(5) New and used school buses for state agencies;
- ~~(7)~~(6) A purchasing card program and travel card program to include implementation and administration; and
- ~~(8)~~(7) An electronic commerce procurement solution to include planning and administration consistent with the established financial systems of the state.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 19-11-223, concerning commodities, technical and general services, and professional and consultant services under state contract, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(f) If the director awards a state contract for the procurement of passenger motor vehicles and trucks, a college or university may elect not to participate in the state contract if the college or university can demonstrate to the State Procurement Director that it can procure passenger motor vehicles and trucks from another source at the same price as the passenger motor vehicles and trucks procured under the state contract.

SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. Applicability. This act applies to procurement under this subchapter on or after the effective date of this act. This act does not apply to a transaction, event, obligation, or duty arising out of or associated with procurement under this subchapter before the effective date of this act.
