AN ACT TO AMEND THE GENERAL PROVISIONS OF THE
ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING RETIREMENT AND PENSIONS; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE GENERAL PROVISIONS OF THE
ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING RETIREMENT AND
PENSIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-11-434(c)(3), concerning the deferred retirement option plan, is amended to read as follows:

(3)(A) A member may enter into employment with a participating municipality ~~other than the municipality he or she was employed by at the time of retirement~~ so long as the member has a break of service from his or her previous ~~employer~~ employment of at least thirty (30) days as a police officer, begins employment in a law enforcement position, and becomes a member of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System.

(B)(i) Subdivision (c)(3)(A) of this section applies to a member of a local police pension and relief fund after the break in service regardless of the original date of hire of the member by a municipality that participates in the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System.

(ii) Retroactive application applies only if the member and employer contributions have been made under this chapter.
